Dear Sir,

I inclose you Plot and field notes of a survey of the Bernard Klocamp League, made to ascertain, if there be any vacancy between said League and the Edmond Osburn survey. I made a carefull survey of said League, but find that the Patented field notes, do not agree with the Original field notes, as made, by Austins Surveyors Messrs. Simms and Shackelford. But the line as found by me will correspond very nearly with the Original survey, also with Harveys, if possible that he started at a cor. 500 paces S 25° W from the Haslet North west cor. I found an old cor. There with X mark on two sides, it is also cor. of a tract purchased of the north end of the S. Haslet, by Phelps, this corner is 6314 paces from Collony line Harvey calls 6350. I submit the field note as I found, lines on the ground and would be glad to hear from, soon as to whether there is a vacancy, or not.
