E. of the Town of San Patricio, on Lake Ramerainew & East of the Nueces River; being the quantity of land to which they are entitled by virtue of a deed received from the Government of Mexico, dated the 9th day of October 1834, and ~~is conveyed in accordance with an act of Congress~~ of the Republic of Texas Approved the 1st day of February 1845.

Beginning at the S. W. Corner of a Survey in the name of Power & Hewitson atty. of Francisco De La Peña, set post for the S. E. Corner from which a Musquit marked P. brs. N. 20° W. 85. vs. also a musquit marked H. brs. N. 33° W. 95. vs.

Thence S 89° W. 2830. vs. to Lake Ramerainew, continued with the meanders of said Lake N 62° W 250. vs. N 25° W. 800. vs. intersected the East boundary of a survey in the name of Julian De La Garza, set post on the north bank of Lake Ramerainew for the S. W. Corner from which a musquit marked P. brs. N. 6° E. 80. vs. also a musquit marked H. brs. N $6^{\circ} 30'$ E. 85. vs.

Thence N. 9° E. 12011. vs. a Musquit for the S. W. Corner, from which a Musquit marked P. brs. N 88° E. 7. vs. also a Musquit M. H. brs. S 30° E. 14. vs.

Thence S 81° E. 3500. vs. to a forked Musquit for the S. E. Corner, from which a Musquit marked P. brs. N 73° E. 3. vs. also a Musquit marked H. brs. N. 85° E. $2 \frac{8}{10}$ vs.

Thence S 9° W. with the West boundary
of Francisco De La Peña's of whom Power &
Newison are the owners, 12.28 1/2 m to the beginning
Corner.

Arable land, the balance pasture land.
