which he is entitled by virtue of a Grant re-  
ceived from the Government of Mexico, dated the  
6th August 1835. And re-surveyed in accordance  
with an Act of Congress, of the Republic of Texas,  
approved February the 1st. 1845.

Beginning 4440. vrs. S.  $71^{\circ}36'$  E. from  
the N.W. Corner of a survey in the name of J.  
Howard, on the East bank of the Nueces River  
Set a post for the S.W. Corner, from which a Hack-  
berry marked H. br. S.  $36^{\circ}$  E. 13. vrs. also a Hackberry  
marked B. br. N  $78^{\circ}$  W. 14. vrs.

Thence N.  $9^{\circ}$  E. at 9223. vrs. Set a post for  
the N.W. Corner from which a Musquit marked  
R. br. N.  $5^{\circ}$  W. 28. vrs. also a Musquit marked D. br.  
N.  $6^{\circ}$  W. 26. vrs.

Thence S  $81^{\circ}$  E. at 2600. vrs. Set post for the  
S.E. Corner, from which a Musquit marked R.  
br. N.  $43^{\circ}$  E. 40. vrs. also a Musquit marked T.  
br. East 33. vrs.

Thence S  $9^{\circ}$  W. at 1713. vrs. the Arroyo  
Henda, runs S.W. 9213. vrs. to the Nueces. Set a  
post for the S.E. Corner, from which an Oak marked  
R. br. S.  $8^{\circ}$  E. 10. vrs. also an Elm marked D. br.  
S  $6^{\circ}$  W 7. vrs.

Thence with the meanders of the Nueces  
S  $86^{\circ}$  W. 70. vrs. S  $60^{\circ}$  W. 1030. vrs. S  $35^{\circ}$  W. 80. vrs. N  $45^{\circ}$
