Dear sir,

In response to your request of the 14th of August I am mailing you under separate cover a new or revised plat of the Bobbie Baldwin lands constructed upon a scale in Varas.

After receiving your request I have had to make a complete survey of the Meanders of Chiltipin Creek as in the first place I was using a plat furnished me by The Humble Oil Co engineers for the present position of the creek Channel and I could not get hold of their meanderings. That accounts for the long delay in complying with your request.

As to the position of the Henry O'Neil and the Theo Carroll surveys I quite agree with you and have so constructed the revised Plat as far as the Henry O'Neil extends and have made an offset in the Carroll South line the width of the O'Neil Mo 1 in order to give the Carroll its Compliment in acreage. Of course this will require a corrected set of field notes for the Carroll if this construction is accepted.

Sorry I have been so long in getting this back to you but it has been unavoidable.

To locate the North line of the Ramon Survey on the ground we followed a meandering survey made by Chas. Bluchers several years ago beginning at a concrete post for the N.W.corner of the Sam Houston Survey and then meandering along the public roads and railroad to a point in a public road and in the North line of the Manuel Ramon Survey 963.3 varas West of the S.W. corner of the Bobbie Baldwin tract.

By calculation we find this distance from the N.W.corner of the Sam Houston Survey to the North line of the Manuel Ramon Survey to be 6216.7 varas on a due North line which is the distance as called for across the Sadler and the Ramon Surveys.
