Dear Sir:

You are referred to a map titled "Neuces Bay and Adjoining Area" Map #10, filed in your office, upon which is shown two tracts designated MF 25465 and 25464, each of which was awarded to the State of Texas in Cause 11294 in the Court of Civil Appeals for the Fourth Appeals District styled State of Texas et al vs. Arnim et al.

As illustrated on said map drawn in accordance with judgment in said Cause, said two tracts appear to be separated by a Bayou.

From an investigation on the ground I find that said Bayou no longer exists and has been completely filled in apparently primarily by silting from the high bluff bank to the North.

This is the basis for my statement that said two tracts have now resulted in the formation of one single tract.
