





In connection with application of J. H. Harlan for mineral permit upon a strip of land in San Patricio County lying between the South and West lines of W. W. Bell Survey No. 3 and the bay shore line, regarding which I received a letter from you under date January 6, 1915, will say that your letter indicates that I must not have made myself clear in my former letter as to the location of this file. I enclose a rough pencil sketch, which will perhaps clarify matters.

I say this in view of the fact that the Mantor file #684 lies in Nueces Bay south of the Hope 61 acre tract, and does not touch the Harlan tract. The Northeast corner of the Mantor Survey would be approximately 38 yrs South of the Southwest corner of the Harlan file. Survey #687 in the name of Custis and Hope is approximately 1-1/2 miles West of the Harlan file. Survey #701 in the name of W. A. Custis is approximately 3 miles Southwest of the Harlan file.

I understand that there is another file made by R. C. Briggs in Nueces County, permit upon which has heretofore been issued. This is not mentioned in your letter, and I do not know the survey number. This lies immediately East of

of the Briggs-Mantor file above mentioned and immediately South and West of the tract covered by the Harlan file. In other words, the North and East line of this last mentioned Briggs file is the bay shore, and the South and West line of the Harlan file is the same bay shore.

I believe that it is this Briggs file that is causing the confusion, and therefore in connection with it I desire to call your attention to the facts as I understand them. The records of San Patricio County and Nueces County and of your office will show them exactly:--R.C.Briggs left his filing in Sinton on the 15th day of April, 1914; this file called for the County line between San Patricio and Nueces County. He learned that some question as to the location of this line existed, and perhaps for this, or some other reason, went from Sinton to Corpus Christi and filed the same application with the County Surveyor of Nueces County. Later he obtained a permit from your office under the Nueces County filing, giving his North and East line as the bay shore. He abandoned his San Patricio filing and the same ran out of date, he evidently being satisfied with the permit granted in Nueces County.

Our client learned of the vacant strip of land lying between the bay shore line and the South and West line of the Bell Survey and filed his application with the County Surveyor of San Patricio County. The latest information we have from the County Surveyor is that the survey will be made this coming week if the weather permits.

We understand that Briggs now contends that the field notes of his original application would extend his line to the South and West line of the Bell Survey. I do not believe there is any merit in this contention, but the question is one of both law and fact, and our client's right having become fixed by the filing of his application prior to any such contention as this having been made by Briggs, I wish to call your attention to this condition of affairs so that we can be heard before you take any action, if such should be requested by Mr. Briggs. There are many other facts and circumstances which go to bear out my contention, but they would be out of place in a letter of this character, and will be submitted when the matter really comes to issue in your office and all parties are notified that you desire to hear from them.

In the meantime I believe that no action should be taken that would affect or complicate the rights of the different parties until the Harlan file is run out and the papers duly returned to your office. Such delay will save a great deal of unnecessary expense and inconvenience to all parties.
