Dear Sir:

Please find enclosed herewith the sketch and field notes of several surveys located in Schleicher County, about 3 to 5 miles North East of Eldorado, County site of Schleicher County, submitted to that department for approval. I have carefully gone over, revised, and corrected the sketch and field notes to conform to your letter of advice as near as conditions surrounding the position of the several surveys would permit, which I trust will meet conditions requisite. In this connection I will state, as you possibly know, that Block EEE was not put in by measurement, but by scaling the distance between the South line of Block LL, T C RR Co on the North and the North Blk line of Blk A, HE&WT RR Co on the South at which time no part of Blk A, HE&WT RR Co had been put on the ground making it impossible to get the exact measured distance North and South between the two Blocks. Now, by reason of nearly all lines of surveys in this Blk LL being more or less excessive the actual survey when measured on the ground placed the South line of Blk LL, a considerable distance South of a position that would have existed if scaled on paper which is proven by the survey just made of this Blk EEE on the ground by myself. I will state also that I carefully measured the distance between the South line of Block LL, T C RR Co and North line of Blk A, HE&WT RR Co (as corrected with corners placed on the ground by W B Silliman in 93 and filed in Genl Land Office as you will see by referring to my letter of Sept 15th) at several points going East along the South line of Surveys 65 and 66, Blk LL, and found the distance much shorter than the original calls of the several surveys in Blk EEE, GC&SF RR Co. Because of this excess in some of the surveys in Blk LL, which in some instances is North and South and in other instances is East and West, the entire Block of LL is placed further east and south on the ground that it originally was on paper. This has shortened the original calls in Block EEE, both North and South. I have preserved all of the original calls in Block EEE that the existing circumstances would permit.

I hope that this work will meet with your approval, and that it can be filed as tendered.
