Dear Sir:

I respectfully submit for your consideration the attached plat and field notes of a survey recently completed by me in the north part of T.W. & N.G. Ry. Co. Block 8, Schleicher County, Texas.

The original survey on Block 8 was done by L. C. Navarro in 1876. In the same year, L. E. Edwards surveyed the G.H. & S.A. Ry. Co. Blocks "H" and "I". Neither of these surveyors placed permanent corners to mark their surveys on the ground.

In 1888 and 1889, Mr. G. M. Williams, a State Surveyor, resurveyed the G.H. & S.A. Ry. Co. Blocks "H" and "I", and set numerous stone mounds with witness trees to mark his surveys. Since these two blocks were dependent upon Block 8 for their location, Mr. Williams re-established Navarro's northeast corner of Survey 1, Block 8, from the Fisher-Miller Colony Surveys, immediately to the east, according to Navarro's calls. From this re-established corner, Mr. Williams ran a line six miles north along a "very old marked line" and set a beginning corner for Block "H" at the southeast corner of Survey 1. He then resurveyed Blocks "H" and "I" from this beginning corner. I recovered all of the corners set by Mr. Williams in this area, as shown on the plat, as well as his re-established northeast corner of Survey 1, Block 8. However, I found from three to ten varas per mile excess in Mr. Williams' work.

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I also located the patented position of Surveys 8, 20, and 30, Block 8.

The surveys in the T.W.& N.G. Ry. Co. Block 8 were then constructed by holding to Williams' corners on the north and west lines, Mr. Goodfellow's patent corners in Surveys 20 and 8, and Mr. Simpson's patent corners on the north line of Survey 30.
