It will be seen from the above sketch the true situation of Levi Cole's Sur. this Sur. was made for Cole in 1838. and for some time I Resurveyed it in 1845 and run on the same lines. there is but one Survey joins the above sketch, a Survey one League for W. D. Anderson running half round the above sketch, which proved to be on a fraudulent Certificate, and Anderson in his life time plung the whole Claim away, which now stands as nothing.
