I herewith send you a sketch map showing John Bradley's $\frac{1}{3}$ of a League, and the surrounding tracts, as they originally stood, or should have stood on the map of this County. There is two reasons to be assigned for its not being designated sooner.

1st The Cullen Tract it calls for Beginning on; is not recorded in this Office, Or if recorded is not Indexed, so as to be found. Search has always been made for it south of the other Cullen Tract.

2^d Its Calls and Location, disagree; it calls for running East with Cullen 3605 varas; Whereas it is only 2310 varas then South with Cullen 3605. so. The Calls should read thus!

Beginning at two Pines marked J.B.H. On Purros & Seurlocks line 500 varas West of the S.W. Cor of E.W. Cullens fractional League. Then East passing Cullens corner and with his line 2310 varas to Cullens N.W. Cor of another Survey two Pines marked E.W.C. Then South 3605 vo. to Cullens S.W. Cor two Pines ^{marked} E.W.C. Then West 2310 vo. to a Red Oak, & Hickory; (marks not legible now) Then North 3605 varas to the beginning. I Geo. W.
