On recpt. of your letter of the 25 ult. I wrote Mr. Howard Trigg, (Surveyor) of Amarillo, and am in recut of Amarillo, and am in recpt. of a letter from him stating that he made a resurvey of all the sections in Sherman county under employment by the County Comrs. of that county, and that he had sent in his field notes, etc. to you for adoption.

I am writing this to protest against the adoption of the resurvey because I think it was done to find excesses of land in order that the surveyor or hi friens may file on the excess lands, or in some way benefit from the work, and because I do not think old settled lines and corners should be disturbed and moved at the whim of a surveyor who wants to profit himself, or for any other very light reason,

I wrote him that he had moved my lines about one-fourth of a mile north cutting me out of level fine land and giving me cap rock and bluffs on the north. His answer to that is that he does not think it is that far.

Some yera ago a surveyor in that vicinity wrote me several letters wanting me to agree to such a surve because he said there was an excess of land there and it ought to be filed on by somebody. I owned secs. 4 and 44 at that time and made a very earnest "kick" against any disturbance of the old lines. Yours truly,
