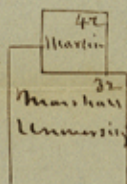

Hill a Deputy Surveyor of the District of Nacagdoches for the County of Smith, do hereby certify upon my own knowledge that the survey of one League of Land in the name of Lucy Watson which is situated on the waters of the Naches, partly in Smith County does not conflict with the Cherokee Boundary line as run by W. A. Harris in 1841 but that S. W. cor of the same is at least two hundred varas in a North East direction from said line

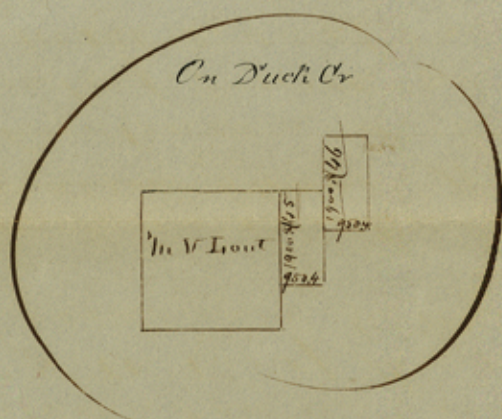
And I do further certify that the survey of Lucy Watson 640 ac No. 20 does not reach the Naches River and that it is impossible for it to interfere with any surveys on the West or South West side of said River.

I can further certify that this is the manner in which No. 42 for Martin joins the survey for Marshall University No. 32.
