


I C C Hill a Deputy Surveyor of the District

Cherokee Boundary line as run by W A Harris in 1841
but that S. E. corner of the same is at least two
hundred varas in a North East direction from said
line


And I do further certify that the survey
of Lucy Watson 640 ac No 28 does not reach
the Neches River and that it is impossible
for it to interfere with any surveys on the west
or South West side of said River.

I can further certify that this is the manner
in which No 42 for Martin joins the Survey for
Marshall University No 32.
