taken by Preemption

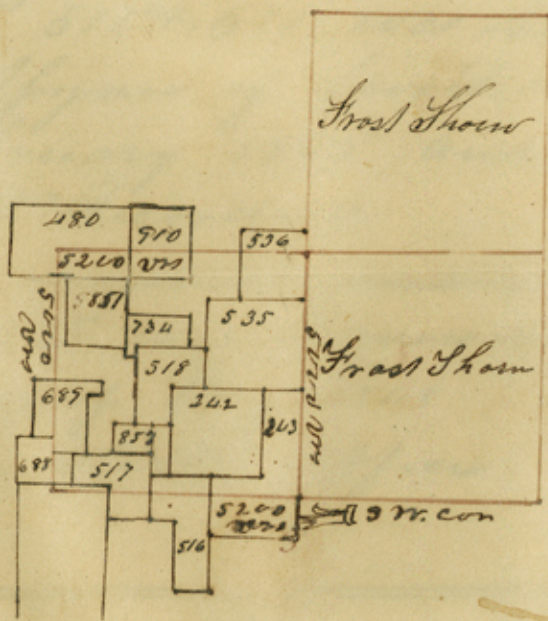
Survey No 852 was Surveyed for R
