Report of Survey of lines run to designate the North West corner known as "Chaparras Pintos" of a Grant of land in Starr County Texas, known as "Palitos Blancos" originally granted by the Mexican Government to "Rafael Garza Sais" being confirmation No 23, for Starr County, by the State of Texas to Antonio Ramirez.

Beginning at an old "Mojonera" or a Stone Monument built of stones and lime mortar, shown me as the North West corner of "Las Animas" being on the South body line of survey No 384, made for Starr County School land, of one league as indicated by Starr County map, or plot of said survey.

Thence West at 403 varas (with a line of fence) (2) two stones under fence, recognized as the South West corner of said one league survey No 384, also the South East corner of league survey No 383, also Starr County school land, at 4764 varas, near "Mogote del Cuero", a stone m.d. under the fence, the South West corner of said survey No 383, also the South East corner of Scrip survey No 468, at 7628 varas the South West corner of Survey 468, and the South East corner of survey No 467 also a corner of a pasture fence, from whence a fence runs South.

Thence, North along a fence at 950 varas, drove a stake & at 1026 varas, a fence runs easterly, supposed to be the North West corner of Scrip survey No 468, also the North East corner of Scrip survey No 467. Back 76 varas to stake at 950 varas.

Thence West, at 2807 varas, a stone corner (2) two large stones placed for the South East corner of "Palitos Blancos" whence a Hackberry mott and Laguna known as "Los Granjenos" brs S. 68 1/4 E. this is apparent by an Ancient land mark, as the sand has been blown out around the stones, making quite a sunken place in the prairie, this is also the reputed N.W. corner of scrip survey No 467 also the S.W. corner of Scrip survey No 243.

Thence North at 3732 vs. the corner of a pasture fence, a fence running East, and at 4264 varas along a fence, another fence corner of a pasture, the fence running westerly at 11,350 vs. drove a stake for N.W. corner of Scrips survey No 392. and at 11,584 vs. crossed a fence line running Easterly, outside and West of pasture having passed a fence at 10,950 vs. running westerly, and at 11,650 vs. drove a stake on South Body line of "San Antonio de Baluarte"

Thence to (2) two Stones in prairie shown me as the North West corner of Starr County League Survey No 381, and ran West at 2788 varas, (2) two large Stones, 43 vs. South of line, and at 5671 varas intersected the line run North (from the (2) two Stones the South East corner of the "Palitos Blancos" Grant) 1150 varas South of stake, the North East corner of "Palitos Blanco"

Thence to the N.E. corner and West at 634 varas a fence running North from (2) two large Stones about 450 varas South at 6236 varas, a Stone mound in a "Chapparre prieto bunch of bushes" on the East Body line of "El Sordo" grant being the point known as "Chapparros Prietos, and claimed and recognized as the N West corner of "Palitos Blancos Grant" a fence reaching the same from Eastwardly, from the (2) two Stones last mentioned, a fence also on the line dividing "Palitos Blanco" and "El Sordo" grants
