Report of a re-survey
of Section 542, in
Starr County, Texas.

Object of Survey: To determine by actual survey on the ground, the true lines of said Section 542.

Surveyed on application of M. M. Garcia, 710 Market Street, Laredo, Texas.

Data for Survey: From Original Field Notes, Corrected Field Notes of said Section 542, and Field Notes of adjoining Sections and Porcion.

Survey was made with a Transit with front and back sights, all angles checked by the needle. Distances were measured with a 100 ft. Steel Tape, converted to Varas.

After considering the field notes of Section 542 and the adjoining Sections, I came to the conclusion that the best starting point was the lower S.W. corner of Section 913, on the East line of Porcion 92. There I found the old squared post set by Surveyor E.J. Foster in 1923, as per Corrected Field Notes and Patent of Section 913. From there I made a right angle from the Porcion line and followed Surveyor Foster's old chopped line for Section 913, and running S. $80^{\circ} 29'$ E., at 990.0 varas set a squared post for an inner corner of Section 542, being the S.E. corner of Section 913 as per its Patent. Then at right angles running N. $09^{\circ} 31'$ E., at 1029.6 varas set squared post on the South line of Section 538, being the N.E. corner of Section 913, and the upper N.W. corner of Section 542. Then following old chopped line and running S. $80^{\circ} 45'$ E., at 615.0 varas passed a squared post, the South common corner of Sections 538 and 539, and at 1287.3 varas found a new squared post, the N.W. corner of Section 541 and the N.E. corner of 542. Then I ran S. $09^{\circ} 10'$ W., 2041.0 varas to a squared post on a North line of Section 970, the S.W. corner of Section 541 and S.E. corner of 542. Then running N. $80^{\circ} 50'$ W., following a North line of Section 970, 163.0 varas to a squared post, an inner corner of Section 970, for a corner of this Section 542. Then running N. $09^{\circ} 10'$ E., 225.0 varas to a squared post, an inner corner of Section 542, and a corner of 970. Then following a North line of Section 970, running N. $80^{\circ} 50'$ W., 2125.4 varas to a squared post on the East line of Porcion 92, the N.W. corner of 970 and the S.W. corner of this Section 542. Then following the Porcion line, running N. $09^{\circ} 31'$ E., 794.0 varas met the place of Beginning.

The attached Blue Print shows graphically how this survey was made, respecting the South and East lines of Section 913 (leaving same as per its Patent) as per your letter to Mr. M. M. Garcia, of November 26, 1940.
