> REPORT OF SURVEY Block 11, S. P. R. R. Co Block 15, H. & T. C. R. R. Co Sterling County

Dear Sir:

During the month of December I made a resurvey of parts of the above captioned blocks. Block 11 was surveyed originally by S. M. Carter in the year 1858, and his survey is fairly well marked on the ground.

I commenced my survey at the Northwest corner of the block, as did Carter, at the Northeast corner of Survey No. 25, Block 12, S. P. R. R. Co. This is an original corner and identified by several surveyors, including Surveyors Kellis, McCombs and myself. I then traversed each tier of sections in the block and recovered and positively identified the original corners made by Carter which are shown on my map which accompanies this report.

For my construction I have used these original corners, using direct courses between them, and pro-rating the distances between them to each intermediate section. The exception is the Southeast corner of Section 15 which was relocated from Carter's river crossing calls.

Since Block 15 was an office survey by Doyle in 1873, and depends for its construction entirely on the adjacent senior Blocks 11 and 12, Section 15 was given its called or field note distance from the West line of Block 11, its East line being identical with the West line of Section 30 of said Block 11.

My survey is tied to the State Co-ordinate System and all courses shown are of the Lambert Grid, Central Zone. Original corners recovered, and corners set by me, are marked by 2" galvanized iron pipes set in concrete.
