chairman of Mr. R. Standeford's 1st Survey
of Stonewall County. When said
Standeford was with the Daniel
Kitchens, B. Haley, J. Martindale, S.
S. Mr. J. Maury and G. H. & H. R. Ru-
no and that he found all the
corners of the above survey as called
for in the field notes of the survey
and they are correctly on the ground
as represented on a plot drawn
by said Standeford.

Also he found at S. W. corner
of Daniel Kitchens (old corner)
and now West 1281 rods
establish the N. W. corner of Mrs. W. Smith's
Survey thence North 600 rods to the
N. E. corner of No. 4 B. S. & F.
thence West 1400 rods to N. W. corner
of No. 4 thence North 988 rods to
N. E. corner of No. 3 B. S. & F. thence West
1250 rods to N. W. corner of No. 3
a pile of stone established by Standeford
thence West 2085 rods to a point

I found the Old corners of the following surveys

I set Daniel Kitchens Wm W Smith Mastendale
Nos 1 2 and 3 W F Maury Philip Commons

Beaty Seal & Forward Nos 1 2 3 and 4 also R Healy
L R London R Batten surveys

Began at the S W corner of Daniel Kitchens
Survey from which a flat Rock N 52 E 7 runs another
flat Rock marked x bis N 5 W 5 runs I set up on
this corner and taken bearing on the X on the Rocks
and found the course to be 30 minutes E
found all the corners as called for in Field notes and
all the call on branches to fit Then I run West-
12 81 runs and established the N W corner of Wm W
Smith Survey Then I returned to S W corner of
D Kitchens Survey Thence E 16 26 runs and established
the S E corner of R Healy Survey Stone mound Meas. by N 8 2 E 16 runs
Thence N 6 7 6 runs Stone mound for S E cor of R Healy and
A and the West- N W cor of Smith Survey

River. Thence South 38.76 rods then a Point

the S.W. corner of M. M. Smith and S.E. corner of No 1

 find old Stone mound, thence East 1344 rods
 finding old Hackco line several times (See Show)
 for S.E. corner of James Martindale No 3 thence N.
 134.4 rods find a large Sand Rock marked
 X thence E. finding old Hackco line at 1340 rods
 West-Bank of Brazos River thence Return to S.W.
 corner of W.F. Many Survey thence North at 400 rods
 a Branch at 1247 rods a deep canon at 1344 rods
 find old Stone mound on West-Side of a small headed
 Hill as described in Field notes from which a cedar still
 standing has N. 17 W. 15 rods also find pile of Stone on
 old mound N. 13 E 28 1/2 rods thence East-
 1348 rods over very rough ground find old Stone mound
 of Slip Rock but did not find the Rock marked
 as described in Field notes but the Rocks are soft-Slip Rock
 then I returned to S.W. corner of W.F. Many
 X thence West- 865 rods find a large Stone mound
 with a Stake in the center of mound thence N. 240
 rods Point in ^{East} line of G.H. & H. RR Co No 1
 X Kearney Peak has N. 22 E. then go to
 H² S.E. corner of J. Martindale No 3 thence S 16 E at 712 rods
 counter 37248



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cross North line of Haley Survey 147 rods West of
 the N.E. corner of Saw Haley Survey at 45-60 rods Point
 for N.E. corner of I Martindale No 2 Thence S 15° E at
 182 rods cross South line of Wm W Smith finding
 old Hackes line at 1344 rods Point for S.E. corner
 of No 2 Thence ^{S 75° W?} W 120 rods for N.E. corner of No 1
 Thence S 15° E finding several line trees Hackes
 at 1344 rods for Point for S.E. corner corner of
 I Martindale No 1 but do not find the rock
 mound a Solid Rock marked X as called for
 in Deeds No 1-C. But what I saw found out from
 the Settlers here one of H. Dolson destroyed this corner
 in order to put in Preventions on the East.)

I then went S 75° W 1344 rods Point for S.E. corner
 of Philip Commons Survey Thence S 75° W 285 rods
 Point for S.E. ^{off?} corner of Philip Commons containing corner
 at 2377 rods find a large rock mound 35 rods South
 of line Thence N 15° Then run from this pole of Stone
 N 15° W 2688 rods Point for N.W. corner crossing several
 very deep Corners at 2888 rods find old Stone mound
 both of these mounds was deeply embedded in the ground
 and I proved that they had been there a long time

(Note) I saw all the corners of Martindale Surveys and also the true line from No 8 to No 2. 1 'M



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and no doubt - there are the Stone Monuments call for
in Philip Commins Survey as no other Surveyor has
ever run on the Partition of 1st West - As found
the N. J. Mearns and Daniel Martindale No. 3.

Now the way I account - for the excess on Daniel Martindale
No. 1 Philip Commins it is a very rough country and the
locations thrown in several rows on the line

now if you hold that I have located the Philip Commins
No. 1 - require a location of the Preemption Surveys
as ^{they} conflict with the J. C. and S. J. Jones Surveys
there is no use to look for the S. E. corner of Daniel Martindale
No. 1 no doubt - it being destroyed as if the Dolman
was very zealous to locate Settlers any where he
could get them to believe there was vacant land
he would go back to East line of B. K. D. and run
East - 73⁰⁰ rows and show a space between that point
and the River and of course this looked plausible
to the Settler. I looked all the country I run South
looking for Solice rock markers & but ~~could~~ could not
find any thing. I spent 2 days looking for this corner
and I very sure it will never be found

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On Oct the 1st 1900 I began at - at the S E
corner of No 5 H & H RR Co State & Mineral at - 240
races Kaway Peak brs N 22 E (Variation 1' W)
at 1902 races find old Stake and Mineral as called for in
Lued notes Thence North at 1900 races on the East
Side of Steep Sep Hill Kaway Peak brs S 28 E
but did not find Rock Mineral and Stake but it had
wash away as it shows the water has wash out great ditch
in the ground I then returned to S E cor of B H & H RR
No 1 thence N 1900 did not find corner, this point,
Soft gap Rock Thence West 950 races for the S W corner
No 3 established Rock Mineral Thence North 3800 races
for N W corner of No 3 and S W corner of No 4 Thence
North 907 races Thence to N E cor of No 3 H & H RR
Blk F Stone Mineral on East Side of Hill
Kaway Peak brs S 59 E Thence East (Variation)
9.45' in E, 1900 races Stone Mineral the S W corner
of 253 Blk F thence East 870 races Stake Point
907 races North of S W corner of No 4 B H & H RR
I also found the S E corner of No 5 Kaway Peak
brs S 45 3/4 E and the S E corner of 253 and N W

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I found the corners of R Butten Survey by running
the line from Nancy Kingston Survey as called for in
Butten Deed note I began at the S.W. corner of R Butten
a Set Stone from which a line to S 85° E 1' 0" runs (Acad corner)
Thence North (variation 9 ^{45'} E) at 262 crosses the North line
of R Haley 255 runs West of the N.E. corner of Said
Haley Survey at 672 runs Set Stone for N.W. corner
of Said Butten Survey and S.W. corner of L R Bondard
Thence North at 273 crosses South line of
Daniel Martindale No 3 47 runs West of the
S.E. corner of Said Martindale No 3 at 662 runs find
Stone mark from which a lead to North 2 runs
another Acad N 88° E 1/2 runs (found as called for in
Deed note) Thence East at 112 runs cross East line
of No 3 Martindale Survey at 1344 runs corner
X I also run from the N.W. corner of No 4 Blk
D He & R R Co Thence East (variation 9 45' min E)
