of Dry branch from which a cedar 10
inc. dia has $S88\frac{1}{2}E43$ versus E a cedar 0.14
in dia has $S71\frac{1}{2}E71$ versus this being the
S.W. corner of Survey No 538 in name
of L. Reimann Fort Linn Survey.

Thence $S10W$ 970 versus crossing dry
branch of Natl Sand 10' extended western
Point of Linn Bluff.

Thence West 1844 versus stake.

Thence South 248 " stake

Thence West 177 versus stake

in bed of Natl Sand. L. O. 14 in dia
has $N42W$ 140 versus stump of L. O. with
mark still showing has $N30W$ 147 versus

this being the S.W. corner of Survey
No 11 in name of S. P. R. R. Co

Thence South 201 versus stake on valley.

Thence West 924 versus stone corner
on side of mountain.

Thence South 942 versus stake in

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the grand & in the field.

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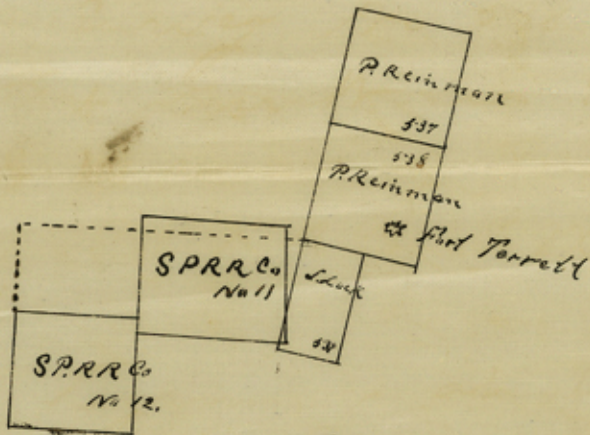
