The surveyor in this report says that he ran <sup>west</sup> from the S.W. corner of N° 88 G.H. & S.A. Blk K and struck the S.W. corner of N° 1 H.E. & W.T. Blk A. at 5700 vrs.

Now if this be true, then said N° 1 is a mile further north or said N° 88 is a mile further south than State Surveyor Williams placed said survey.

But if surveyor in this report intended to write N.W. instead of S.W. corner of N° 1 Blk A, he would make it only 5700 vrs from said N.W. corner of N° 1 to S.W. corner of N° 33 H.E. & W.T. Blk A when the maps show this distance to be 7600 vrs.

Let this connection be returned to surveyor asking an explanation of this discrepancy.
