No. 17, GC&SFRRCo., whence a L 0 9 in. in dia. mkd. x brs S 22 E 75 vrs, a L 0 10 in. in dia. mkd. W brs S 89 E 267 vrs. Original call for this corner a L 0 8 in. in dia. mkd. x brs S 22 E 75 vrs, a L 0 10 in. in dia. mkd. W brs S 89 E 270 vrs.

Thence West with N line Sur. No. 12, 1947 vrs to a large stone mound made by me, for N E corner Sur. No. 11 and N W corner said Survey No. 12, GC&SFRRCo., whence a L 0 8 in. dia. mkd. x brs S 88 E 214 vrs, a L 0 9 in. dia. same mark brs S 88 1/4 E 216 vrs.

Thence West with N line Survey No. 11, 1970 vrs to a stone mound marked N W 11, at the N W corner Sur. No. 11, N E cor 14, S E cor 15, and S W corner Survey No. 16, whence a x cut on a fixed rock brs N 21 1/2 E 25 vrs, a L 0 6 in. dia. marked S brs S 66 3/4 W 34 1/2 vrs.

Thence North crossing Val Verde and Sutton County line at 1750 vrs, a branch in all 1952 vrs, a rock mound, cap rock marked N W 30 made for the N W corner Survey No. 30 and S W corner Survey No. 31, CCSDandRGNGRRCo., whence a \bar{s} cut on a fixed rock brs N 75 1/4 E 18 4/5 vrs, a do. brs S 85 E 19 vrs.

Thence ran West 1975 vrs to a large stone mound near extreme head of deep ravine for N W corner Survey No. 41 and S W corner Survey No. 40, EL&RRRyCo., whence a cedar 7 in. dia. marked A brs S 13 W 16 vrs, S cut on a fixed rock brs S $75 \frac{1}{2}$ W 29 vrs.
