Field notes of a connecting line run from the SW corner of Survey No 1, HE&WT RR Co, Blk A, same being the NE corner of Survey No 31, SW 26, and NW corner of Survey 38, TWNG RR Co, Blk 9, West 1900 vrs, South 5700 vrs and West 15200 vrs to the SW corner of Sur 124, SE 153, HE&WT RR Co, Blk A, same being the NE corner survey 4, GC&SF RR Co, of which the following are field notes.

Beginning at a stone md at bottom of large post cap stone marked SE 1 A at the SE corner of Survey No 1, HE&WT RR Co, Blk A, and NE Cor Sur No 34, NW 33 and SW Cor Sur No 26, TWNG RR Co, Blk 9, whence a mesquite 10" marked X brs S $10\frac{1}{2}$ E $12\frac{1}{2}$ vrs a mesquite same mark brs S $53\frac{1}{2}$ W 44 vrs, established by W B Silliman July, 1899, filed for record with D W Maddox, County Surveyor of Menard Co Oct 18th, 1899, and filed for record in General Land Office Jan 15th, 1900.

THENCE West with South line Survey 1, Blk A, HE&WT RR Co, same being North line Survey 34, TWNG RR Co, Blk 9, at 1900 vrs made a stone md, marked cap stone SW 1 A at the SW corner of Survey 1, SE 30 and NE 31, Blk A, and NW Survey 34, Blk 9.

THENCE South with the East line Survey 31, Blk A, at 1900 vrs made a stone md, whence another md cap stone marked SW 31 A, under net wire fence brs East $2\frac{1}{2}$ vrs.

THENCE South with East line Sur 32, Blk A at 1900 vrs made a stone md cap stone marked SE 32 A at the SE corner of Sur No 32, NE 33, Blk A, whence another old stone md brs S 89 W $4\frac{1}{2}$ vrs a mesquite 9" marked X (old mark) brs S 25 E 79 vrs;

THENCE South with E line Sur No 33, Blk A, at 1900 vrs made a large stone md cap stone marked SE 33 A and NW 46 9 at the SE corner of Sur 33, Blk A, HE&WT RR Co and NW Corner of Sur No 46 and SW 44, Blk 9, TWNG RR Co a large stone md (old md) in bed of drain brs N 66 W $10\frac{1}{2}$ vrs a LO 7" marked X and S (both old mrks) brs S 16 W 33 vrs X cut on fixed rock (old mrk) brs S 72 W 31 vrs;

THENCE West with S line 33, Blk A at 1900 vrs made a stone md cap stone marked SE 34 A at the SE Cor Sur 34 SW 33, Blk A, whence a LO 16" marked S (old mark) brs N $6\frac{1}{2}$ E 100 vrs a LO 12" marked X (old mrk) brs S $79\frac{1}{2}$ W $50\frac{1}{2}$ vrs.

THENCE continuing West with South line Sur 34, Blk A at $12\frac{1}{2}$ vrs cross Bill Miers net wire fence 7 vrs South of the NE corner in all 1900 vrs, made a stone md in drain cap stone marked SW 34 A at the SW cor of Sur 34, SE 36, Blk A, whence a LO 12" marked X (old mrk) brs N $62\frac{1}{2}$ W 59 vrs tree on W side of RR.

THENCE West with South line of Sur 63, crossing the GC&SF RR Co track at 1900 vrs made a stone md cap stone marked SW 63 A at the SW Cor of Sur 63, SE 64, Blk A, whence an old md brs N 1 E 15 vrs a LO 12" mkd X (old mrk) brs N 39 E 66 vrs a LO 20" same mrk (old) brs S 87 W 79 vrs.

THENCE West with South line Sur 64, Blk A, North line Sur 9, GC&SF RR Co 1900 vrs to a stone md cap stone marked SW 64 A at the SW Cor 64, SE 93, Blk A, same being NE Cor Sur 8, and NW Cor 9 GC&SF RR Co whence another md (old md) brs N $7\frac{1}{2}$ E 12 vrs a LO 8" marked X (old mrk) brs N 75 W $57\frac{1}{2}$ vrs a LO 7" marked S (new mrk) brs S $43\frac{1}{2}$ W $12\frac{4}{5}$ vrs;

THENCE West with South line of Sur 93 at 1900 vrs made a large stone md near East bank of drain cap stone marked SW 93 A at the SW corner survey 93 SE Cor 94, Blk A and NE Cor Sur 7, NW 8, GC&SF RR Co, whence another md marked SW 93 (old) brs S $44\frac{1}{2}$ E $2\frac{1}{2}$ vrs a LO 8" marked S (new mrk) brs N 29 E 115 vrs a mesquite 12" marked X (over old mrk) brs N 42 E 102 vrs;

THENCE West with South line Sur 94 at 20 vrs E bank of drain in all at 1900 vrs made a stone md on North side of hill cap stone marked SW 94 at the SW corner of Survey 94, SE 123, whence another md (old md) brs S $18\frac{1}{2}$ E 12 vrs cap stone erroneously marked SW 123 A a LO 18" marked S (new mrk) brs N $5\frac{3}{4}$ E 115 vrs a S cut on a fixed rock brs N $6\frac{3}{4}$ E $5\frac{2}{3}$ vrs.

THENCE West with South line of Survey 123, this Blk crossing West fork of Conchondraw of Devil's river at 1900 vrs made a stone md in a mesquite flat marked cap stone SW 123 A at the SW Cor of Survey 123, SE 124, Blk A, and NE Cor Sur 5, NW 6, GC&SF RR Co, whence another md marked SW 123 (old md) brs S $12\frac{1}{2}$ E 22 vrs, a LO marked S (new mrk) brs N $15\frac{1}{2}$ W 114 vrs a LO 20" same mrk (new mrk) brs N $43\frac{1}{2}$ W $143\frac{1}{2}$ vrs.

THENCE West with South line said Survey 124, Blk A at 1900 vrs made a stone md marked cap stone SE 153 A at the SE corner of Survey 153, SW 124, Blk A, HE&WT RR Co, same being NE corner Survey 4, NW 5, GC&SF RR Co, whence a forked LO 25" marked S (new mrk) brs N $40\frac{1}{2}$ E 63 vrs an old md of stone cap stone marked SE 153 brs S $63\frac{1}{2}$ W 106 vrs and from said old md a LO 8" marked X (old mrk) brs N $5\frac{3}{4}$ E 41 vrs.
