REFERRED TO MAP

Dear Sir:

I will state that, The surveys I wrote you about in my last letter four days ago, that conflicted, namely 23rd and 22nd E. L. and R. R. Co (on my sketch prepared for Arthur and Fred Simmons) conflicts with Survey 16 G.C. + S.F.R.R. Co this is a long section 1/2 mile wide and 2 miles long and lies just South of Blk A H.E. + W.D.R.R. Co. I surveyed out there on the Simmons ranch 3 days in Blks B, 7, 2, + W.D.R.R. Co. and Blk II, G.C. + S.F.R.R. Co. but owing to having to do so much channing did not get to that part of the country where this conflict exists, but am going out again in the morning to survey section 10 R.S. Hamilton and Survey No 72 1/2 Blk J, R. for patents. and when I return will send in field notes, for these surveys. also a sketch showing where or this conflict exists or no. I further wish to state that the survey I made for Mr Bill Wiers of surveys 13rd and 14th ^{about 1 mile east of the Davis survey.} are wrong in their distances North and South. They show to be on the blue print I you sent me to be N. + S. 1986 vrs when they should be the same distance N. and S. as is shown on surveys 18 + 19 surveyed for R. W. Davis ^(B.P.) on sketch No 37, which is 1780 vrs from the North line of Blk B H.E. + W.D.R.R. Co to the South line of surveys 13 + 14 Blk A, G.C. + S.F.R.R. Co, I have not the sketch by me, but the distance North and South on the Bill Wiers survey of surveys 13rd and 14th G.C. + S.F.R.R. Co North and South show to be 216 vrs too much and is an error in channing of 216 vrs I will write you again when I return from the Simpson survey which will be Friday 10th of November, until then, I will say with best regards. goodbye,
