REFERRED TO MAP

Dear Sir:-

In compliance with my letter of the 21st of November last I am enclosing a tracing showing my construction and the way in which I arrived at same of E.J.Parker survey No. 3, Sutton County.

Some ten years back I did some surveying for Mr. R.F. Halbert of this place in the South end of Block D, G.C. & S.F.R.R.Co., which included surveys 29 and 44 of Block D. I adopted and used the N.W. corner of survey No. 44 as made by Mr. E.C.Saunders, which is marked on the enclosed map, and from this corner I ran East to a point in my West line of Block B, H.E. & W.T.R.R.Co, which gave me 1900 varas plus the 1269 varas shown on the map for the width of the T.B. Starkey, D.H.Corbin and the E.J.Parker surveys.

As I have been informed of late this agrees with Mr. Saunders present survey within 19 varas; Mr. Saunders now making the width of these surveys to be 1250 varas.

The Starkey, Corbin and Parker surveys otherwise being located in accordance with their field note calls.

The East tier of surveys in Block D were located by me from a survey on the ground ~~of~~ from the N.W. corner of survey No. 6 Block D (the original corner being identified my me), giving the surveys East and South their call distance of 1900 varas.

This places the E.J.Parker survey in conflict with survey No. 74 Block D to the extent of 168.3 varas.

Mr. Saunders maps on file in the Land Office, copies of which I have, shows the same construction, in other words Mr. Saunders shows the N.W. corner of survey No. 6 Block D to be the furthers South and East original corner in Block D found and identified by him in his surveys.

Since Mr. Saunders has adopted my West line of Block B, our construction seems to be identical, therefore it is only a matter of surveying on the ground and I believe that my work is correct.
