Dear Sir:

I am returning the Sutton County Sketch with the additional information requested by you, together with the field notes of survey number 54, T.C.Ry.Co., Block IJ, and field notes of survey number 8, G.C.& S.F.RR.Co., Block H.

The boundaries of survey number 54, T.C.Ry.Co., Block IJ, were determined by locating the east line of Block IJ from the two original corners at the southeast corner of survey number 2, Block IJ and the southeast corner of survey number 11, Block IJ. The courses shown on the enclosed sketch are the same as the courses on sketches of the north and west parts of this Block which I have previously filed in your Office.

The Bee County School Land Survey number 8, surveys number 9 and 10, B.S.& F., and the McMullen County School Land Survey number 3 have the following relation on the ground: Beginning at an old stone mound in the south line of the McMullen County School Land Survey number 4. Said stone mound is three feet at base and three feet high with one stone marked "4" situated on a hill at the head of a ravine coursing southwest into the main valley of Devil's River: Thence N 89° 37' W 528.0 varas to an old stone mound on hill overlooking the valley of Devil's River. Said stone mound is situated on the west edge of the hill above the cap-rock bluff, about 250 varas east of stock pens and windmill. one stone marked "N E 8", a X has been cut in the cap-rock under the mound, Thence S 0° 23' W --- at 2656.0 varas pass stone mound on the edge of the east bank of the main channel of Devil's River, one rock marked X --- in all 2836.0 varas to a large rock mound about three feet high composed of large rocks one rock marked " S E 8 ": Thence N 89° 37' W --- at 2836.0 varas pass the southwest corner of Bee County School Land Survey number 8, placed field note distance from its southeast corner --- in all 3036.0 varas intersect the east line of survey number 54, Block IJ, 230.7 varas S 0° 43' 30"W from its northeast corner.

Returning to the rock mound of large rocks, one rock marked S E 3, at the southeast corner of the Bee County School Land Survey number 8: Thence S 89° 37' E 408.0 varas: Thence S 0° 23' W 937.0 varas to an old stone mound at the west foot of a hill, one rock marked "N E 3 ", from which a Live Oak stump nine inches in diameter and six feet high marked " \overline{A} " bears N 70° E 39 varas; a Live Oak twenty inches in diameter marked " \overline{X} " bears S 69° E 20 varas, The northwest corner of the McMullen County School Land Survey number 3 is placed field note

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distance N 89° 37' W from its original northeast corner. The southwest corner of survey number 9, certificate 1/554, B.S.& F., is located in the north line of the McMullen County School Land Survey number 3 its field note called distance from the above stone mound described as the original northeast corner of the McMullen County School Land Survey number 3. The southwest corner of survey number 10, B.S.& F., is located in an extension of the north line of the above survey number 3, field note distance from the southwest corner of survey number 9. The west line of survey number 10 is excessive in order to reach the westward extention of the south line of the Bee County School Land survey number 8.

Survey number 8, certificate 4/1391, G.C.& S.F.RR.Co., Block H, has only one original corner on the ground and it is located at its southwest corner. Survey number 15, certificate 387, C.T.& M.C.Ry.Co., was surveyed and located in between survey number 8, Block H, on the southeast and surveys number 2 and 5 on the northwest, and its field notes were approved by the General Land Office. This fact was treated as having broken any adjoinder call survey number 8 might have had for surveys number 2 and 5, Block H. Therefore I have placed the corners of survey number 8 course and distance from the original corner at the northwest corner of survey number 7 this Block, using same as the original southwest corner of survey number 8, Block H.
