Brown Prumptier Survey said corner is marked on the Map with the letter A and I hereby certify to the same and by examining the field notes as forward up from this office you will find the connecting line drawn from that corner (No A) and by applying the same scale to the connecting line that the survey was plotted to you will find my statement true I know from my own knowledge

being both present when the Survey was made on the Ground and also when the field notes were made out to send up to Genl Land Office also the J. H. Cornwell Survey is in conflict with the W Dean Survey as represented on said Map and further the Dean Survey is in conflict with the S Townsend Survey as represented on said Map
