Hereby certify that the following statements concerning certain surveys in Taylor County are correct, as found by actual measurement on the ground, and that the accompanying plates correctly represent the relative positions of the surveys herein referred to.

On the 1st November 1878 I found the N.E. corner of H. T. & G. Ry Co Survey No 147 - a stake from which a live Oak bears N. $80\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 264 Yrs.

at 1900 Yrs West from said corner found U.W. corner of No 147 and N.E. corner of No 146 - a stake from which a Mesquite bears W. $32\frac{1}{2}$ ° Yrs - Church Mt bears S. 44° W.

At 1900 Yrs West from last above found the S.E. corner of Survey No 164 - a Mesquite 5ⁱⁿ dia. Grs S. 44° W. 134 Yrs - another 4ⁱⁿ dia. Grs S. 74° W. 87 Yrs, - stone mound for corner.

On Nov. 22nd 1878 I ran West 1900 Yrs from S.W. corner of No 164 East described corner - crossed Cottonwood Creek at 80 Yrs - recrossed same at about 160 Yrs and at 180 Yrs - at 1900 Yrs found S. W. corner of No 167 - One Mesquite bearing found -

Thence West 1900 Yrs to a stake for the S.W. corner of No 168 - Mesquite Grs S. 34° E. 57 Yrs - another Grs S. 49° E. 45 Yrs.

Thence ran South 1480 Yrs - Thence East 935 Yrs - Thence South - at 290 Yrs cross Valley Creek - at 350 Yrs found N.W. corner of the Wm S. Henry Survey - a stone mound from

which are Elm trees $N.59\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}W.$ 112 Yrs - and a Post Oak tree $S.85\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}W.$ 131 $\frac{1}{4}$ Yrs. - At S. W. corner of N° 164 is 1830 Yrs North and 2865 Yrs East from the N.W. corner of the W.S.S. Henry Survey. On the following day I ~~found~~
traced the West Boundary of the Henry Survey and found the S. W. corner of same, a stake from which a Post Oak tree $S.45\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}E.$ 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ Yrs, another tree $S.37\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}E.$ 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ Yrs.

On the 21st November 1878 I found the N.W. corner of J.P. Ry Co Survey N° 1 - corner on a Spanish Oak 6 in dia - Post Oak tree $N.40^{\circ}E.$ 5 Yrs - Spanish Oak tree $S.16^{\circ}E.$ 15 Yrs. ^{Latter} Both Bearings cut down, Cut marks found on stumps.

Hence East - at 669 Yrs stone mounted at S. W. corner of N° 4 - bearings $N.36^{\circ}E.$ 34 - another $N.75^{\circ}E.$ 36 Yrs.

Hence North - at 4800 Yrs found stone mid Cedar tree $S.89^{\circ}W.$ 110 Yrs - another tree $S.81^{\circ}W.$ 120 Yrs. - the N.W. cor. of N° 5 and S. W. cor. of N° 8.

Hence West - at 1900 Yrs stone mounted on side of hill for S. W. corner of N° 9 and S. E. corner of N° 15.

Hence West 1900 Yrs to stone mounted on hill for S. W. corner of N° 15 - Cedar stump tree $S.60^{\circ}W.$ 6 Yrs - another Cedar stump tree $N.34^{\circ}E.$ 14 Yrs. Both trees down but found on ground marked X.

Hence ^{then} North 1900 Yrs and made mound of rocks and cones for N.W. corner of N° 15.

1 Hence North 2600 Vrs - N. 30° E. 1200 Vrs -
2 and made mound.

3 Commenced Nov 22/78 at mound named
4 above and ran N. 45° E. 6725 Vrs and
5 N. 15° W. 1508 Vrs to N. W. corner of Guadalupe
6 County School League (Survey N° 145.)

7 (I had a few weeks before found the
8 N.E. corner of Goliad County school League - a
9 Stake and stone mound from which a Mesquite
10 Bros N. 6½ W. 10 Vrs - another Bros S. 10 W. 10 Vrs). - Hence
11 ran N. 15° W. 10700 Vrs, at Variation 10° 10'
12 East and found Stake and stone mound for
13 S. E. corner of Grimes County School League -
14 Survey N° 146 - Mesquite Bros N. 11° W. 20 Vrs.

15 Hence ran S. 75° W. 5000 Vrs and found stone
16 mound made for S. W. corner of said Grimes
17 Co School League. Said corner is 9852 Vrs
18 North and 4966 Vrs East from N. W. corner
19 of J. P. Ry Co Survey N° 15.)

20 From S. W. corner of ^{said} Grimes County School
21 League ran N. 15° W. - at 2940 Vrs crossed
22 Mulberry or Evans Creek - at 3200 Vrs Stake
23 and stone mound - Mesquite marked R Bros
24 N. 10 W. 52 Vrs - another marked X Bros N. 56° W.
25 60 Vrs - at 3495 Vrs found stake and stone
26 mound - Mesquite unk R Bros N. 86° E. 19 Vrs -
27 another unk X Bros N. 45½° E. 29 Vrs.

28 Hence S. 77° W. - at 3602 Vrs found stake
29 unk T. 18. W. 5. S. B. - Live Oak Bros S. 92° E. 51 Vrs -
30 another Bros S. 27° E. 193 Vrs. - Both Bearings unk
31 as stake. (S. E. cor of N° 1 and S. W. cor of N° 2.)

32 Hence S. 77° W. 1900 Vrs to a stake

1 uckd T. 18 - T. 19 - Mesquite Bros S. 35° E. 118 Vars -
 2 another Bros S. 19° W. 62 Vars.

3 Nov 23/78 - Thence S. 77° W. - 1900 Vars to a
 4 slate uckd T. 19. W. 1 - & S. 8. S. B. - Mesquite Bros
 5 S. 57° E. 67 Vars - another Bros S. 20° E. 114 Vars.

6 Thence S. 77° W. - at 1700 Vars Branch - at 1900
 7 Vars stone mound - Mesquite Bros N. 85° W. 32 Vars.

8 Thence S. 77° W. - at 1900 Vars slate uckd T. 19. S. 8. B.
 9 S. B. - Cedar Bros N. 53° W. 6 Vars - Hackberry Bros N. 21° W.
 10 10 Vars.

11 Thence S. 77° W. 1072 Vars and made stone mound
 12 Mesquite Bros N. 67° W. 6 1/4 Vars - another Bros N. 57° W.
 13 16 1/4 Vars. Low Mt Peak Bros N. 73 3/4° W.

14 Thence South - at 9158 Vars stone mound from
 15 which a Mesquite Bros S. 80° E. 30 Vars - and another
 16 Bros S. 17° E. 30 Vars.

17 Thence West - at 1052 Vars stone mound from
 18 which a Mesquite Bros S. 41° W. 6 Vars - another
 19 Bros N. 44° W. 12 Vars.

20 Thence South - at 1900 Vars slate at S. W. cor.
 21 of U. 62 - Mesquite Bros N. 7° W. 65 Vars - another Bros
 22 N. 9° W. 30 Vars.

23 Thence ran East 1900 Vars and made stone
 24 mound for S. E. corner of U. 62 - Live Oak 28 in
 25 dia. Bros N. 31 3/4° W. 114 Vars - Cluster of small Live
 26 Oaks Bros S. 31 3/4° E. 215 Vars, Castle Mt Bros N. 85° E.
