4 concerning certain surveys in Taylor County are
5 correct, as found by actual measurement on
6 the ground, and that the accompanying plat
7 correctly represent the relative positions of
8 the surveys herein referred to.

9 On the 1st November 1878 I found the
10 U. E. corner of H. & J. S. Ry Co Survey N^o 147 - a
11 ~~state~~ ~~from~~ ~~which~~ a Lone Live Oak Brs N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W.
12 264 Vrs.

13 at 1900 Vrs West from said corner found
14 U. W. corner of N^o 147 and U. E. corner of N^o 146 -
15 ~~a state from which~~ a Mesquite Brs W. 324
16 Vrs - Church Mt Brs S. 44° W.

17 At 1900 Vrs West from last above found the
18 S. E. corner of Survey N^o 164 - a Mesquite 5ⁱⁿ dia.
19 Brs S. 44° W. 134 Vrs - another 4ⁱⁿ dia. Brs S. 74° W.
20 87 Vrs, - stone mound for corner.

21 On Nov. 7/78 I ran West 1900 Vrs from
22 S. W. corner of N^o 164
~~last described corner~~ - crossed Cottonwood Creek
23 at 30 Vrs - recrossed same at about 130 Vrs and
24 at 180 Vrs - at 1900 Vrs found S. W. corner of
25 N^o 167 - One Mesquite Bearing found -

26 Thence West 1900 Vrs to a state for the
27 S. W. corner of N^o 168 - Mesquite Brs S. 34° E. 57
28 Vrs - another Brs S. 49° E. 45 Vrs.

29 Thence ran South 1480 Vrs - Thence East
30 935 Vrs - Thence South - at 290 Vrs cross Valley
31 Creek - at 350 Vrs found U. W. corner of the
32 W^m S. Henry Survey - a stone mound from

1 which an Elm Crs N. $59\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 112 Vrs - and a
 2 Post Oak Crs S. $85\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. $13\frac{1}{4}$ Vrs. - The S. W.
 3 corner of U^o 164 is 1830 Vrs North and 2865
 4 Vrs East from the N. W. corner of the W^{ms} S.
 5 Henry Survey. On the following day I found
 6 traced the West Boundary of the Henry Survey
 7 and found the S. W. corner of same, a stake
 8 from which a Post Oak Crs S. $45\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. $32\frac{1}{2}$ Vrs,
 9 another Crs S. $37\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. $37\frac{1}{2}$ Vrs.

 12 On the 21st November 1878 I found the N. W.
 13 corner of J. P. Ry Co Survey U^o 1 - corner on a
 14 Spanish Oak ^{6ⁱⁿ} Dia - Post Oak Crs N. 40° E. 5 Vrs -
 15 Spanish Oak Crs S. 16° E. 15 Vrs. ^{Latter} ~~Both~~ Bearings cut
 16 Down, but marks found on stumps.

17 Thence East - at 669 Vrs stone mound at
 18 S. W. corner of U^o 4 - mesq. N. 36° E. 34 - another
 19 N. 75° E. 36 Vrs.

20 Thence North - at 3800 Vrs found stone mt
 21 Cedar Crs S. 89° W. 110 Vrs - another Crs S. 81° W. 120
 22 Vrs. - the N. W. cor. of U^o 5 and S. W. cor. of U^o 8.

23 Thence West - at 1900 Vrs stone mound on
 24 side of hill for S. W. corner of U^o 9 and S. E. corner
 25 of U^o 15.

26 Thence West 1900 Vrs to stone mound on
 27 hill for S. W. corner of U^o 15 - Cedar stump Crs
 28 S. 60° W. 6 Vrs - another Cedar stump Crs N. 34° E.
 29 14 Vrs. Both trees down but found on ground
 30 marked X.

31 Thence ^{ran} North 1900 Vrs and made mound of
 32 rocks and bones for N. W. corner of U^o 15.

1 Thence North 2600 Vrs - N. 30° E, 1200 Vrs -
2 and made mound.

3 Commenced Nov 22/78 at mound named
4 above and ran N. 45° E. 6725 Vrs and
5 N. 15° W. 1508 Vrs to N.W. corner of Guadalupe
6 County School League (Survey N^o 145.)

7 (I had a few weeks before found the
8 U.E. corner of Goliad County School League - ^{N^o 143} a
9 stake and stone mound from which a Mesquite
10 Brs N. $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 10 Vrs - another Brs S. 10° W. 10 Vrs. - Thence
11 ran N. 15° W. 10700 Vrs, at Variation $10^{\circ}10'$
12 East and found stake and stone mound for
13 S.E. corner of Grimes County School League -
14 Survey N^o 146 - Mesquite Brs N. 11° W. 20 Vrs.

15 Thence ran S. 75° W. 5000 Vrs and found stone
16 mound made for S.W. corner of said Grimes
17 Co School League. Said corner is 9852 Vrs
18 North and 4966 Vrs East from N.W. corner
19 of J. P. Ry Co Survey N^o 15.)

20 From S.W. corner of ^{said} Grimes County School
21 League ran N. 15° W. - at 2940 Vrs crossed
22 Mulberry or Evans Creek - at 3200 Vrs stake
23 and stone mound - Mesquite marked R Brs
24 N. 10° W. 52 Vrs - another marked X Brs N. 56° W.
25 60 Vrs - at 3495 Vrs found stake and stone
26 mound - Mesquite mkt R Brs N. 86° E. 19 Vrs -
27 another mkt X Brs N. $45\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 29 Vrs.

28 Thence S. 77° W. - at 3602 Vrs found stake
29 mkt T. 18. W. S. S. B. - Live Oak Brs S. 32° E. 51 Vrs -
30 another Brs S. 27° E. 193 Vrs. - Both Bearings mkt
31 as stake. (S.E. cor of N^o 1 and S.W. cor of N^o 2.)

32 Thence S. 77° W. 1900 Vrs to a stake

1 nkd T. 18 - T. 19 - Mesquite Brs S. 33° E. 118 Vrs -
 2 another Brs S. 19° W. 62 Vrs.

3 Nov 23/78 - Thence S. 77° W. - 1900 Vrs to a
 4 stake nkd T. 19. W. 1 - & S. 8. S. B. - Mesquite Brs
 5 S. 57° E. 67 Vrs - another Brs S. 20° E. 114 Vrs.

6 Thence S. 77° W. - at 1700 Vrs Branch - at 1900
 7 Vrs stone mound - Mesquite Brs N. 85° W. 32 Vrs.

8 Thence S. 77° W. - at 1900 Vrs stake nkd T. 19. S. S. B.
 9 S. B. - Cedar Brs N. 53° W. 6 Vrs - Hackberry Brs N. 21° W.
 10 10 Vrs.

11 Thence S. 77° W. 2072 Vrs and made stone m^d -
 12 Mesquite Brs N. 67° W. 6 3/4 Vrs - another Brs N. 57 1/2° W.
 13 16 1/4 Vrs. Lone Mt Peak Brs N. 73 3/4° W.

14 Thence South - at 3158 Vrs stone mound from
 15 which a Mesquite Brs S. 80° E. 30 Vrs - and another
 16 Brs S. 17° E. 30 Vrs.

17 Thence West - at 1052 Vrs stone mound from
 18 which a Mesquite Brs S. 41° W. 6 Vrs - another
 19 Brs N. 44° W. 12 Vrs.

20 Thence South - at 1900 Vrs stake at S. W. cor.
 21 of U° 62 - Mesquite Brs N. 7° W. 65 Vrs - another Brs
 22 N. 9° W. 30 Vrs.

23 Thence ran East 1900 Vrs and made stone
 24 mound for S. E. corner of U° 62 - Live Oak 28 in
 25 dia. Brs N. 31 3/4° W. 114 Vrs - Cluster of small Live
 26 Oaks Brs S. 31 3/4° E. 215 Vrs, Castle Mt Brs N. 85° E.

 30 Vaughan (Lower survey in that name) on East
 31 side of the Clear Fork of Brazos - Mesquite Brs
 32 S. 17 1/2° E. 80 Vrs - another Brs S. 26° E. 60 Vrs - Both
