Connecting Line from the North West Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup>. 1, in Block N<sup>o</sup>. 1, made by virtue of Certificate N<sup>o</sup>. 706 issued to The Texas Central Railway Company by the Commissioner of the General Land Office, to the mouth of Independence Creek and thence to Ladd's Spring and thence to Myers Spring.

Beginning at the North West Corner of said survey N<sup>o</sup>. 1 and the North East Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup>. 9 in same block, said corner is a rock mound, built in a valley from whence a bush on a round top hill bears South 15° - East - thence South 45° - West 2688 varas to a stone mound, from whence a point of a mountain on the South Side of Independence Creek bears North 53° - East. Said rock mound is the South West Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup>. 9 in said block N<sup>o</sup>. 1 made in name of the Texas Central Railway Company - thence North 45° - West 2688 varas to a mound, built on a rocky bluff above valley, the South East Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup>. 6 University Block N<sup>o</sup>. 34, said corner is the North West Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup>. 10 in said block N<sup>o</sup>. 1 L. 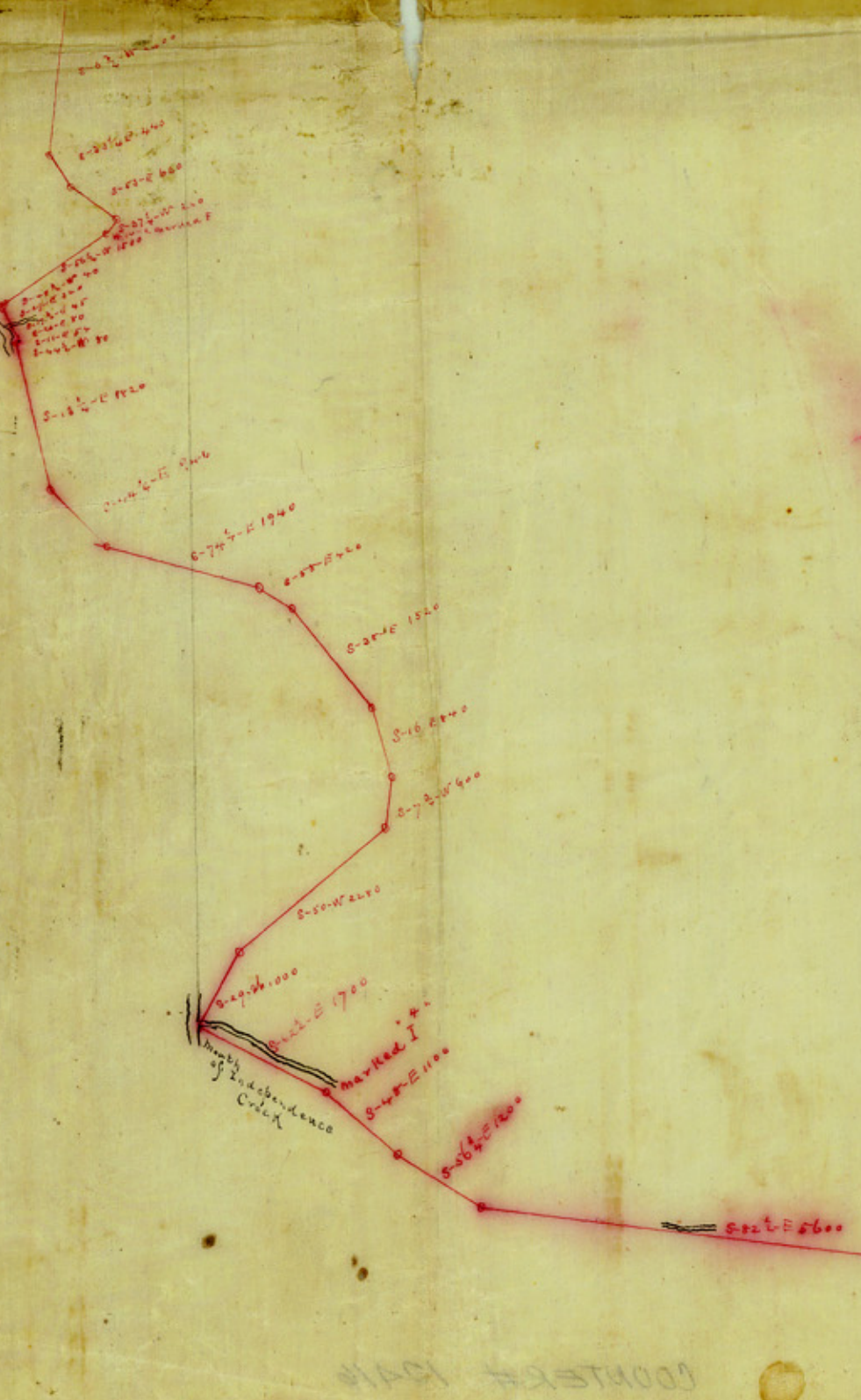
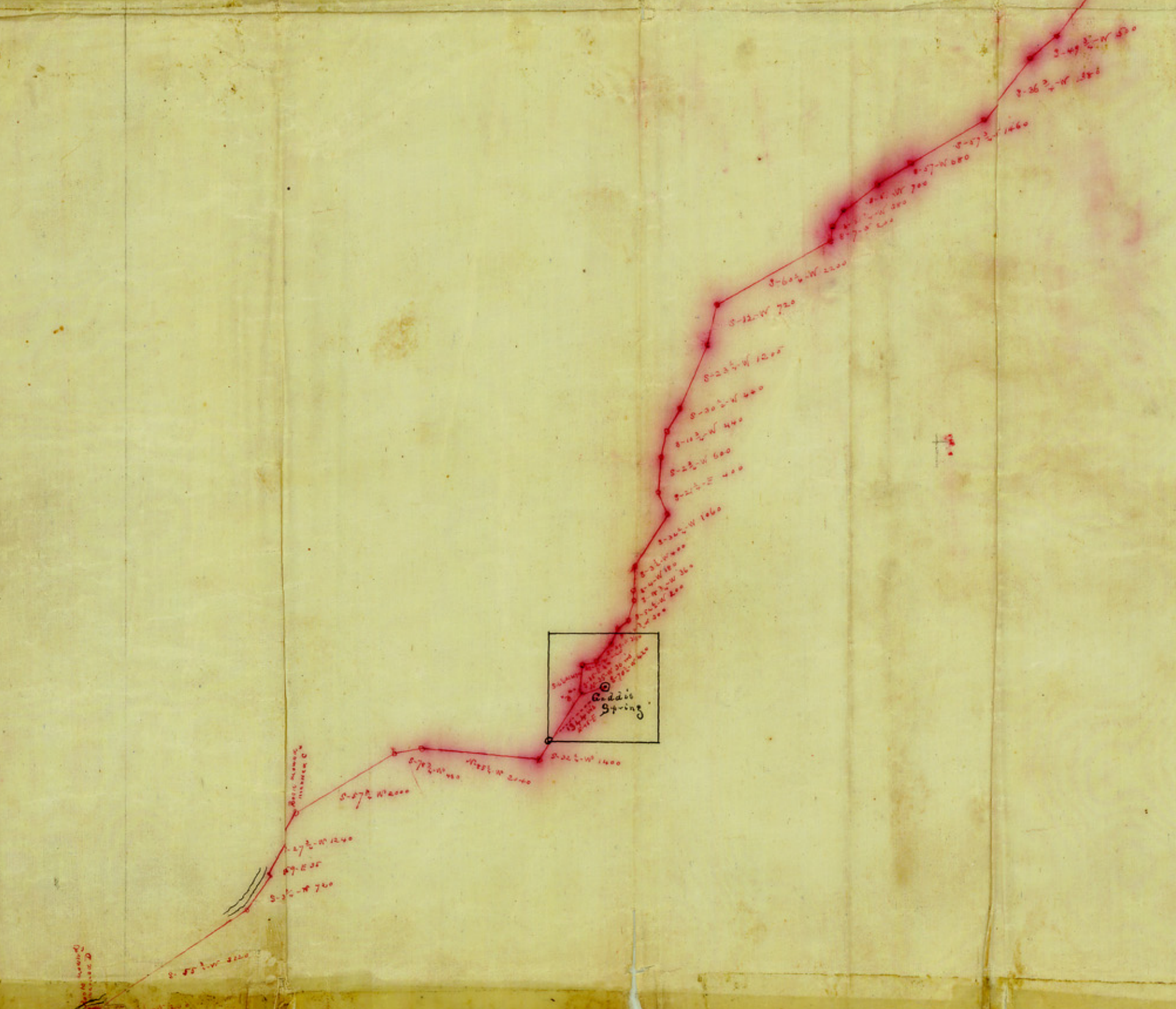
