My Dear Sir:-

I have your letter of May 14th, before me which is a reply to my letter of April 28th, relative to construction of Blocks in Terry County. I have just noted that my reference as to section 42 Block T was an error, it should be section 42 Block D11.

I am enclosing a diagram of blocks in Terry with the connection run by myself shown in dotted line from the old corner used at Double Lakes in Lynn County.

The sections shown with heavy led crosses is the sections that I was employed to locate, I located them running west allowing for divergence from the NE corner section 2 Block E, section 1 Block D-11 I located 15 miles west of said section 2 Block E, thence true south for the other surveys in Block D-11.

You will note that the pencil line extending south from the NW corner 17 Blk E is shown to be  $N0^{\circ}17'W$ , this puts the north end of this road some 71 varas to far west, Ragsdale put this road in and the farmers moved their fences further west to correspond to the road line; this of course leaves a shortage between this road and the lines further west as I have located them under the call of field notes tying through Block E to Block D-11.

I am positive that my work on the ground is correct and if your office can approve the construction as I have constructed the work on the ground, I would be glad to hear from you at once, as I have some 30 other sections all in Block D-11, E and D-8 to survey and would like to have your opinion of my construction before proceeding further.
