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SURVEYORS REPORT

Re: E/2 Section 11, Block C-37, Public School Land, Terry County, Texas

Block C-37 was originally surveyed by W.D. Twichell, State Surveyor, in 1902, for the Public Free School Fund by virtue of an Act of the First Called Session of the Twenty-sixth Legislature and approved February 23, 1900. Most of his field work consisted of traverse lines along the boundaries of the blocks, with marked stones being called for. One exception was at the Northeast corner of Section 20, Block C-31, lying to the South of said Block C-37, where he called for an iron pipe along with the stone. This iron pipe was later recovered and identified by Sylvan Sanders, State Surveyor, when surveying the E/2 of Section 11, the SW/4 of Section 14, and the NE/4 of Section 10, all in Block C-37.

Mr. Sanders began surveying under Mr. Twichell, and was a Party Chief for him in 1917 while quartering lands within this area for the Santa Fe Railroad. Mr. Sanders had first hand knowledge of the Twichell work of 1902.

Some thirty-five years ago, under the employment of C.A. Tubbs, Surveyor, we found a 1" iron pipe as identified by Mr. Sanders at the Northeast corner of Section 20. A few years ago I again recovered and identified the 1" pipe, finding it was now bent from road maintenance. A ¹/₂" iron rod with marked cap was placed along side to help preserve it.

This area has long been under cultivation, with graded roads bounding most of the sections. Through erosion and by deep breaking plows, most monumentation has long disappeared. An iron pipe at the Northwest corner of the SW/4 of Section 14, and another at the Northwest corner of the S/2 of Section 10, as well as the Northeast corner of Section 20, Block C-31, was recovered. We find that the distances, both North-South and East-West agree very closely with Mr. Sanders' work mentioned above.
