Dear Mr. Rudder:

Recently, we have made a resurvey of lands owned by Swenson Land and Cattle Company, located in Throckmorton, Baylor and Haskell Counties. This is known as the Throckmorton Ranch, and is located principally in the B. B. & C. Railroad Company Block, but also covers a part of Block 1, G. C. & S. F. Railroad Company.

The original survey, in these Blocks, was made by Surveyor S. H. Butler, in the years 1881 and 1883. In 1927, George M. Williams made a resurvey of this area, at which time he identified many of the Butler corners. In addition to this, Williams, himself, set corners on practically all the Surveys in these Blocks. Sometime after George M. Williams had completed his survey, he wrote corrected field notes of the many Surveys in this Ranch, and they were filed in your office. These notes have all been approved, and Deeds of Acquitances for the excess have been issued on most of the Surveys, based on the George M. Williams resurvey.

During recent years, it has become necessary for Swenson Land and Cattle Company to conduct a mesquite eradication program, and during the course of the work, a great many of the corners, identified and set by George M. Williams, have been destroyed.

The purpose of our resurvey has been to restore a good deal of the Williams work, which has been destroyed. Under separate cover, I am sending a duplicate tracing of the map of our resurvey, with a request that it be filed in the rolled file of Throckmorton County, so that a record of the original work by S. H. Butler and George M. Williams may be perpetuated. Our resurvey map is self-explanatory,

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inasmuch as the legend sets out these various corners. In addition to that, we have also set a great many corners, which are also delineated on our map.

It is the hope this map will remain in your archives, so that the location of these lands will not be lost to posterity.
