



William M. Williams Esq. Sir. Doct W. M. Burris of your county called upon me to furnish a connection of a survey in the name of W^m Watts for 3.613.369 sq. or a 640 ac. situate in Titus County near Trents Crispings and on the South side of Sulphur; and mail it to you at Paris, as his agent or attorney to procure a patent. I have been much afflicted lately with Neuralgia or a disease of the nervous system, consequently not so able to attend to the matter as I could desire. I have never seen any map of Titus by any one, nor have I been able to make one, or indeed none can be made complete from the books as they stand in my office.

I have given above a sketch of a few surveys near the claim of Watts. But am unable to connect with any known patented land a train of surveys — I have been waiting a few days since Dr Burris was here for the arrival of Mr R. Wilson, my deputy in Titus, who resides in the vicinity of the land, to get further information, but he failing — I must accordingly to promise forward this little to you — probably the means of accomplishing the object may be at discretion.
