Please find below field notes of a connecting

line made in Tom Green Co. and Comanche.

Beginning at a stone mound on the north side
of China Pond on the road from Centralia Station
to the Horsehead crossing on Pecan River. Said
mound being 3250 vrs N. 75 E. and 960 vrs S. 15 E.

from S. E. cor No 21 G. C. & S. F. R. R. Rock mound

Thence from said rock mound, near China
Pond, South 2740 vrs pt Thence West 950 vrs

to a pile of rock on side of hill, the N. E.

cor survey No 12 Block 1. M. H. & T. R. R. Co.

Thence West 1900 vrs to a rock mound, the N. W.

corner No 12 and N. E. corner No 13, same block

from which a white spot in mountain, bears

West. Thence West 1900 vrs to a rock mound

the N. E. corner of sur. No 16 and the N. W. cor.

No 10 said Block No 1. Thence West 3940 vrs

to a point near fork of Mountain. Thence North

thence N. 12 3/4 W. 513 vrs. Thence S. 69 W.
220 vrs to a point in road on bank of Pecos
River, at a ford known as the Horsehead crossing.
There is no other crossing on said River for many
miles up or down.

Beginning at a stake in the road at the Horse
head, crossing on Pecos River. Thence N. 17 1/4 W.
240 vrs, point. Thence S. 40 W. 40 vrs point. Thence
N. 20 1/2 W. 500 vrs. Thence N. 08 3/4 W.
54 vrs, to an earth mound the S.E. corner
of Juan Cordona League, this point was iden-
tified as follows. Beginning at the point
where the road from Horsehead crossing enters
Salt Lake. Thence S. 40 vrs. Thence East 114
vrs, established an earth mound for S.E.
corner of said League.



Field notes of a connecting line established
Block 35. Survey S. N. P. & R. R. Co.

Beginning at the S. E. corner of Juan Cordona
League Thence South $28\frac{3}{4}$ East 3654 vrs. point
Thence S. $33\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5655 vrs point. Thence East 522
Thence S. $10\frac{1}{2}$ E. 240 vrs a

crossed in road at Horsehead crossing
said river. Thence down said river with its
meanders to a point 1140 vrs South, and 7157
vrs East of said Horsehead crossing, this point
is also, 19606 vrs South and 12659 vrs East
of S. E. corner Juan Cordona League, made a
large earth mound for the S. W. corner of Sec
No 1 in Block 31. Thence down said river with
meanders, running its course S. 50 E. and
40 W. so as to follow the course of same, making
all S. 4995 vrs and East 44918 vrs, to a point
at the East end of Pontoon Bridge on Becal River.
This point is 580 vrs N. $46\frac{1}{2}$ 70 vrs East of the N. E.
corner of sec. N. 36 for N. P. & R. R. Co. a rock
mound, one marked "N. 4 G. N."

I hereby certify that the above distances were
carefully measured on the ground, and all the
lines both natural and artificial, as
described in the survey as shown by the
accompanying sketch. A slight excess was
found in the surveys made by the Surveyors
of Palo Pinto District. The Surveyor of said dis-
trict used a variation of $12^{\circ} 18'$ East, as my
variation was $10^{\circ} 30'$ East. I changed the call
of his lines to read S. 75 W. and S. 15 E. instead
of S. 77 W. and S. 13 E. as called for in his field

notes. On adopting this course I found his course
to agree with surveys made by the Surveyor of
Tom Green Land District
