



A report of the general course of the Pedernales from the mouth of Cypress (a tributary of the Pedernales) to mouth of Pedernales made at the request of Congress. Collected & furnished.

Beginning on East bank of the Pedernales opposite the mouth of Cypress

Turned down said Pedernales with its meanders so with N 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 650 m - N 50 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 320 m - N 68E 180 m - N 50 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 57 m - N 62E 300 m - N 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 290 m - N 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 400 m - left Pedernales on the left

Turned N 31E leaving Pedernales on the left 2180 m -

Turned S 59E 400 m - leaving Pedernales on the left -

Turned N 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 1000 m - to Pedernales bluff crossing a bend in said stream - 2500 m left said Pedernales on the left

Turned East 1560 m - to Pedernales bluff crossing a bend in said stream - 3170 m - on East bank of Pedernales

Turned N 50E 400 m - leaving Pedernales on the left

Turned N 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 1540 m - leaving Pedernales on the left

Turned N 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 1100 m - leaving the Pedernales on the left

Turned N 11E 1860 m - leaving the Pedernales on the left

Turned N 17 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 520 m - to Pedernales bluff

Thence N 64° E 200 m - to the mouth  
of the Pedernales -

Walking the general course of the

as - N 40° 28' E - 13.789 m

I then run from the mouth of the  
Pedernales S 24° 37' M 950 m -

Thence N 45° W 1665 m - struck the  
the Pedernales bluff & run across a bend in

the Pedernales did not measure down  
to the water the bluff being impassable  
but supposed it about 200 m - to the

the place where the river turns N 45° E
