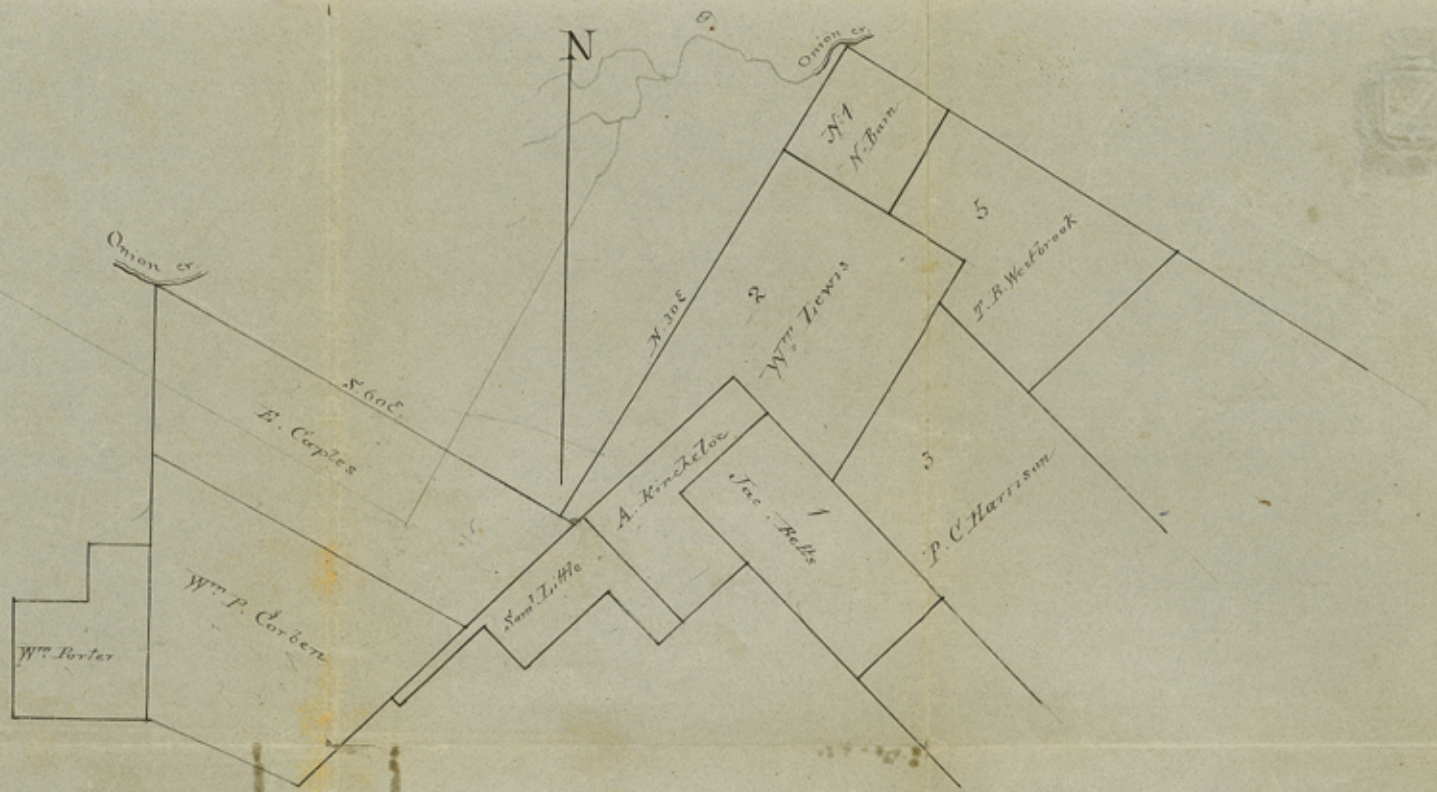

This is to certify that the above sketch truly represents the relative position and connection of the Surveys thereon represented, and particularly of the E Caples survey, as surveyed by me in the Spring of 1838; At that time I was furnished with a sketch by B Sims - then District Surveyor of Bras top - with instructions to work according to the same; that sketch represented the Del valle ten League grant and Cal Caldwell's 7 League grant to corner together on Onion creek at the point where I began the Bain Survey No 1. The beginning of the Caples survey is actually at the 5th corner of William Lewis' Survey No 3 (or as above shown) which I then supposed to be 400 rods S 60^o E from the S. corner of the Del valle grant, of which I had found neither lines nor corners, adjoining my work, and was therefore led to believe it was never run out the same remark apply to the old work on Onion creek.
