Beginning at the upper

corner of the H P Hill Lease on the Colorado River Thence N 60 W 793 us and Thence N 30 E to a point on the Colorado River to where I found an Elm 36 in marked S bis S 70 W 26 us and a ditto 24 in marked T bis S 41 W 11 us. This I took for the lower corner on the River of the D Thomas Survey I found other lines from this corner not marked.

Thence N 19 1/2 W 640 us N 25 W 590 us with the River to a point on its bank a Hackberry marked M. 15 in bis S 34 W 12 us and an Elm marked I. 13 in bis S 74 W 11 us a line marked from this point S 30 W these marks were found by me on the ground and taken for the upper corner of the D Thomas Survey and lower corner of the Wm Brown Survey.

Thence N 60 W 1090 us and N 30 E to a Stone buried on the bank of said River an Elm H 20 in bis S 45 W 8 us a ditto A 15 in bis S 9 E 13 us - & a line beased S 30 W. This I took for the upper corner on River of the said Brown Survey and the line beased his West line

The Lewis P Cooks Survey Begins on the upper corner on said River of W Sparks Survey and Thence up the River with its meanders to give a front to said Cooks of 2000 us and Thence begins the Gray Survey No 2 on the upper corner on said River

of said Cook survey and thence up said
River The said surveys of Thomas and
Brown do not take up all the vacancy

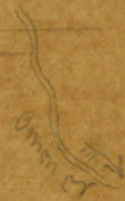
