I enclose herewith a report of progress made in the resurvey of certain Blecks of Land in Upten and Creckett Counties, made for Messrs Nelke & Murphy, at the request of Mr.L.L.Farr of San Angelo, as their agent.

to whom I have sent a copy of Map and Report.

The conditions found are peculiar in this that the three curveys reported from Ponteon to Grierson differ from a quarter of a mile to three quarters in the distances given east and west, and from 500 yrs to 1250 yrs from south to north, and each man claims to have actually measured it.

The original surveyor makes a misstake of a mile west in his first six miles through Blk 1 U.L. from Grierson, and then we find no trace of his work until we reach some rock mounds evidently put in from Pontson. The facts would seem to imply that much of the work in the U.L.Blocks called for in the field notes was not put in on the ground ,or, if put in, is so far from the position called for that it can not be found by running from the the corners that were put in.

It is not a hard country to survey and the main points at Pontoon and

Griersen are absolutely fixed and easily identified, and any such errors as appear in the earlier surveys and connections run are inexcusable.

Mr.Farr had made a survey in 1911 starting from Grierson, and he kindly let me have the field notes of his run , part of which I refer to in my report. In the midst of some much confusion and misstatement, it was a great help to me to be able to check our run by Mr. Farrs survey.

Mr. Friends survey from Ponteon was evidently carefully made and is eerrest as far as I have shocked on it , and I believe will be found accurate

all the way through to Blk 13.

The marks we placed on the west line of Blks 4 & 5 U.L.if you approve our construction, will give the corners of the surveys in the Blocks west and all that remains is to check on Footes corners and the corners run from Ponteen so as to exactly determine area and location of the strips

of unsurveyed State land found on this survey.

There seems to be seme uncertainty as to location of river surveys near Pentoen and their position relative to Bonnells block run in from Lancaster. Mr Neelke seemed to wish me to return and straighten this out, but I understand that MrMFriend has already made the connection from Laneaster to Penteen, and the connection to Grierson which is given in this report was all that was required to enable your Office to pass on that survey, which showed a tract of unsurveyed State land north of Bonnells Blk H.H.

Will you kindly look over my report at your convenience and instruct as to what changes if any should be made in our construction of surveys, and what further work you may think necessary to settle the matters at issue.
