Dear Sir, Enclosed are the Field notes and map of 8 sections of land in Reagan and Upton Counties, This survey, in every respect conforms to recent work done by me in this locality, sketches of which are on file in the Land Office.

About the only explanation I have to make is that I conformed to the Southern reservation of the T.&.P. for all East and West lines, and in the C.C.S.D.& R.G.N.G. Blocks I allowed excess East and West, which I prorated through Blks A. B. and C. around and up to section 56 which call's for the corners of the T.&.P. Block 40. But in Block D. D.&.W. and Blk.C. L.&.S.V. I allowed no excess East and West, as the Sections along the Reservation line of the T.&.P. does not call for the corners of the T.&.P. except at a point east of this work, hence the T.&.P. would have no influence to give excess in any of the land up to the East line of the Throckmorton School Land. I allowed no excess North and South in any of these Blocks, furthermore there are no remaining evidences of original corners found on the ground after I leave the T.&.P. reservation. several corners with bearings are called for and some natural objects. I made a report about three years ago in which I attempted to work these Blocks out but with no satisfactory result as to finding any thing original.
