Uvalde - Beginning at State V. pile of rocks found

both of the Old Bearings Standing but dead. Took New Bearings to wit a cedar sin dia 85° W. 32 1/2°. Another sin dia 85° W. 26 1/2°

Thence Randoms up the river with its meanders to wit - 1st N 40 E. 192 1/2 2nd N 32 E. 83 1/2 3rd N 19 1/4 W. 48 1/2 to mouth of a branch 4th N 30 1/2 E. 68 1/2 5th N 57 1/2 E. 65 1/2 6th N 70 E. 68 1/2 7th N 30 E. 34 1/2 8th N 43 1/4 W. 160 1/2 9th N 13 1/2 E. 143 1/2 10th N 7 1/2 E. 96 1/2 11th N 70 E. 72 1/2 12th N 25 1/2 E. 92 1/2 13th N 33 E. 126 1/2 14th N 34 E. 227 1/2 15th N 10 E. 90 1/2 to point no sign of the corner the main channel of the river here is S 70 W. 286 1/2

Then again for front of Survey no 194. 1st N 70 E. 134 1/2 2nd N 20 E. 800 1/2 pt on the West bank. 3rd N 36 1/2 E. 238 1/2 pt on East bank. here made Memorandum point which is N 20 W. 96 1/2 from where should be the corners of Surveys 194 and 195 but no sign of the corners -

Then again for the fronts of Survey no 195 1st N 20 W. 150 1/2 2nd N 25 E. 200 1/2 3rd N 42 1/2 E. 200 1/2 4th N 63 1/2 E. 360 1/2 5th N 30 E. 400 1/2 6th N 20 E. 180 1/2 pt in the mouth of Lake creek 7th N 16 E. 207 1/2 the creek from here is S 70 W about 500 1/2 8th N 35 1/2 E. 200 1/2 to point in river - 9th N 39 E. 267 1/2 point where is a reestablished corner of Survey no 195 and 90 1/2 short of its meander and the West bank of the river from here S 70 W is 900 1/2 again

1st N 20 W. 38 1/2 2nd N 19 E. 98 1/2 front of Survey did not find corners - 4th N 19 E. 582 1/2 5th N 27 W. 260 6th N 4 1/2 W. 200 1/2 to the place of the beginning. 7th N 20 W. 335 1/2 8th N 70 E. 78 1/2 9th N 20 W. 130 1/2 pt 10th N 20 E. 56 1/2 pile rock the corner of
