In regard to the field notes of Surv. No. 1002 of 1280  
Acres - made for State for T. H. Miller - would state  
that it was made in order to correspond with Conner-  
tions as I now have them of Blocks A & B with Dry  
Hill Surveys - I did on the ground connect  
N. E. Cor. of No. 368 with the Stone Mt. on East line  
of Sq. No. 33 - I find by this, actual position of N. line  
of Block A. to be 320 P. S. 20 ft. <sup>below distance</sup> as given in field notes.  
--- I find that the Connection of Chandler below  
of the one above does not correspond - my connec-  
tion corresponds - with his lower - but still  
there is such a great difference - that I think  
it will be necessary to run upper Connection again.  
- the mystery might be solved if I find Surplus  
in Sqs. 954 - 955 - 698 - 957 & 958 - I have been  
repeatedly urged to forward field notes of  
No. 1002 - I wish you would not act on  
them for the present - until I get some
