I, Andrew J. Baker, Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, do hereby certify that this sketch is a true ~~and~~ copy of a sketch (marked Crockett County sketch file A) on file and an archive of this office, with the boundaries of an application dated June 4th 1877, made by Jacob Kuechler for survey by virtue of Gulf Western Texas & Pacific Railway Company certificates numbers from 1/81 to 1/71 indicated in blue solid lines thereon, a certified copy of said application being also on file in this office. That the Northern portion of said application is in conflict with surveys nos. 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 28, 41, 42, 43 (South 1/2 of 44, 45, 46 & 71) 72, 77, 78, 83, 84, 87, 88, 89, 96, 97, 98, 99, 104, 105, 106, 107, 114, 115, 116 & 117 made by Jacob Kuechler Deputy Surveyor of Texas Land Dist. on the 13th to 15th days of November 1877 by virtue of certificate issued to the Dallas & Wichita Rail road Company, in what is known as Block E, that said Dallas & Wichita Railway company surveys were subsequently abandoned, and the land appropriated by virtue of Gulf Colorado & Santa Fe Railway Company certificates as evidenced by application dated November 18th 1881 and known as surveys nos. 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 28, 41, 42, 43 (South 1/2 of 44, 45, 46 & 71) 72, 77, 78, 83, 84, 87, 88, 89, 96, 97, 98, 99, 104, 105, 106, 107, 114, 115 & 117 all in Block F, made by Will H. Donnell Deputy Surveyor of Texas Land District on the 19th to 20th days of December 1881 and which surveys were patented on the 13th to 16th days of November 1882.

I further certify that the red solid lines on this sketch indicate the boundaries of an application

dated May 29th 1877 made by Jacob Kuehler for
 survey by virtue of G.W. Western Roads & Pacific
 Ry Co. certificates Nos. 1/23 to 1/40 a certified
 copy of said application being also on file
 in this office, and I further certify that the
 records of this office show, that at the time, to wit
 November 15th 1877, that surveyors nos. 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6.
 7. 8. 9 & 10 Block H by virtue of certificates
 nos. 1/13. 1/69. 1/68. 1/67 & 1/66 issued to the G.W.T & P.
 Ry Co. were made, that the land upon which
 said certificates were located was vacant, unap-
 propriated public domain, and subject to
 location by said certificates.
