7 Beginning at a stone mound about
 8 4 feet high near head of a drain at the
 9 N.W. Corner Survey No 17 S.W. 30 N.E. 31 and S.E. 32
 10 G.C. & S.F.R.R.Co. Whence a Lo 8' in dia marked P by
 11 S 64 1/2 W. 111 1/4 W. a Lo Stump 4' in dia by S. 73 1/2 W.
 12 101 1/4 W.

13 Thence South with W. line said Sur No
 14 17 at 260 W. Cross drain in all 1955 W. an
 15 old rock mound in W. edge W. flat at the
 16 N.W. Corner Sur No 15 and S.W. Cor 17. Whence a
 17 Lo 12' in dia marked R. Mark very dim,
 18 by N. 83 1/2 W. 50 1/4 W. a Lo 8' in dia marked S.
 19 (very dim) by S. 57 1/2 W. 62 W.

20 Thence South with W. line Sur No 15 at
 21 800 W. cross a dry branch in W. flat at 970
 22 W. N.E. Corner Lute Hodges W. P. fence in all 1954
 23 W. to a pile of rocks at S.W. Corner Survey No 2.

24 Thence west at 819 W. center of dry branch
 25 in all 1952 W. to the original N.W. Corner Sur
 26 No 1 Cert No 4766 G.C. & S.F.R.R.Co. an old stone mound
 27 whence a Lo 9' in dia marked W. by S 89 W. 267 W.
 28 a Lo 7' in dia marked X by S 22 1/2 E. 75 W.

29 Thence South 1952 W. to an old stone
 30 mound original S.W. Corner Sur No 1 S.E. No 12 G.C. &
 31 S.F.R.R.Co. N.E. Corner Sur No 2 and N.W. Cor No 3 C & M. R.R.
 32 Co Block B Whence a Lo 16' in dia marked Y by S.

19 Thence west over high mountain at 1000 W
20 cross a point of mountain in all 1931 W made
21 a stone mound. Cap rock marked NW 2 at the
22 N.W. Corner Sur No 2 and N.E. Corner Survey No 3, G C
23 S F R R Co whence a 20 7 in dia marked 3 br N 89 1/2
24 W. 115 1/2 W a 3 cut on a fire rock br S 59 W 36 1/2 W.

25 Thence west at 1138 W summit of a long
26 ridge extending N.E. in all 1931 W to a rock
27 mound on N. point of mountain at the N.W.
28 corner Sur No 3 and N.E. Corner Sur No 4.

29 Thence south with W line said Sur No 3, cross-
