Dear Sir:

For the purpose of showing that certain vacancies covered by Surveys numbers 927 and 928 in the name of James V. Dignowity do exist in Kinney County State of Texas and for the purpose of showing the true and correct location of Surveys numbers 1 and 2, BK 4 and N^o 8 BK 3 I + G. N. R. R. Co. and 5 in the name of James Mitchell, and numbers 161 $\frac{1}{2}$ + 161 $\frac{3}{4}$ in the name of John Kientle, and 696 $\frac{1}{2}$ in name of J. L. Martin, as they exist by actual Survey made Officially by myself upon the ground, I hereby respectfully submit the following Report.

On the 10th day of February 1885 I proceeded to the South East corner of Survey N^o 1 BK 4, I + G. N. R. R. Co it also being the Beginning corner of Survey N^o 2. Same BK and Co, which I clearly identified as such, beyond a question of doubt, by its Original Marks and bearings to wit: A large mound of earth (5' x 5') with some

rocks in middle, from which the
Conical Hill East of the Town of San
Felipe, bears S. 33° East. Thence West
from this corner 40 varas the road from
San Felipe to Siuegas Spring, and Fort
Clark and Stockton Road - (For second
angle from above named corner to
Conical Hill West 3555³/₄ varas bears
S. 58° E) ~

I also further identified the above des-
cribed earth mound as the true and
correct South East corner of said Survey
No. 1, as called for in the Original
field Notes, as the same was estab-
lished in October 1846 by my deputy
Surveyor A. Wycheski, who, after
erecting said mound and taking bearings
from same to Conical Hill, showed
me said corner with others he had
established, so as to convince me
that his work was correct and
carefully made. ~

From said South East corner of said
Survey No. 1, reversing the calls of
connecting line to South West corner
of Survey No. 8 Bk 3. I & G. N. R. R. Co.,
I ran with compass and chain South
170 varas a point.

Thence East 2280 varas the San Fel-
ipe Creek (the same being about 60
varas wide at the point of crossing)

to 2

from which North 511 varas West Spring
of said Creek, and from crossing of
said Creek North 292 varas and West
54 varas to initial point of San
Felipe Irrigation Co. ditto, the same
course East from the crossing of said
Creek $244\frac{1}{2}$ varas a point from
which the East Spring of San Felipe
Creek bears North 520 varas, the
same course East from said point at
 $5098\frac{1}{2}$ varas the said South West
Corner of said Survey No. 8 Block
No. 3 above mentioned. And I hereby
certify that I actually surveyed the
said corner ⁱⁿ line upon the ground,
together with its crossings of the San
Felipe Creek, its bearings upon
the West and East Springs of the
San Felipe Creek, and upon the in-
itial point of the San Felipe ditto,
and its terminal point of the S. E.
Corner of Survey No. 1. Bk 4 T 4 S N. R.
R. Co., as the same is actually sit-
uated upon the ground and is
identified by its bearings upon the
Conical Hill as aforesaid, and
find the same as herein stated
and as represented on the Map hereto
attached and made a part hereof, all
of which is hereby respectfully submitted
