You who discover the E. Merid Grop
Surveys as just made by me, contain more
200 or more than you represent to me in your
field notes and maps I have been a practical
Surveyor for years and have never met with
such luck before. I found very readily the
S. & E. you represent by commencing at the N & E
of the Stephens Sur. Thence to 820 N. but here you shut
300 N. of mine W B line. I then run W to W B L and
run for the S W. C. here could find nothing in
Scrib Prairie. Then set out to find the S W line
and finally found it 500 N. N. 10 W from where
I stopped run down upon it and established
my corner. I find this line N 55 W 1575 N. I came
upon your corner giving full satisfaction
I then run N 53 E nearly through and found
this would not do. I then went to mine N W C
and set out it 45 W 1902 N. (No sign of Christman's
line)

Found no corner here after spending hours I then goes
back to N.W.C. makes my calculation and set out
again N 45 E at 2125 N. ran out 10 N in advance
of the 1902 N. here I made my corner in the edge
of a Brush Prairie where nearly all the timber
had been burned down, I then goes to gun up.
resurveyed S.E.C. and ran to 300 N. establishing a corner
on Mues W.B. line. You will discover that the blocks
are larger than you had desired in the North and
western portion of this Survey there is large scrub
Prairie destitute of timber hence the enlarged and
oblonged size, was to give to each block a sufficiency
of timber.

I start out at Mues N.W.C. show 150 N. thence to
1234 N to E.B. line of school land, here I could find
no corner 180 N. I proper direction size and
distance I find gun P.C. no B.C. I also find
a line marked west to an old corner 300 W of Mues
N.W.C. This line continues W. + N. there being so
many old lines here in this vicinity could not accept
it. I then goes and runs down the E.B. line of
school land which is plainly marked and established
my corner

I then goes and runs down S. Mues E.B. line out
to his S.E.C. and find myself 180 N.W. of the Rose
Prun N.B. line I pass Mues corner as you wish to this
line thence to 400 N. passing Proctor N.W.C. 272 corner
in scrub Prairie, thence S 45 E 385 N. here I find my
E.B. L. no such trees in these woods as you represent
passing with corner into valley to W.B. line.

The 2 Southern blocks here are probably larger
than you desired but to give timber to each
could not make them smaller nearly all
scrub Prairie and very rich all tillable.
I am of opinion that More has moved his sur
N 180 N. and to 300 for the purpose of selling a
lot of gun timber which he did to Ellis Prather.
More had out and left about 12 months ago.

I quit work and went to Canton to see if this sur
had not been moved but could find no trace
of record and was assured that there was no corner
in the office of this sur. Is there not a probability
of its being vacant, - as your facilities are
better for ascertaining this fact, ^{than mine} I wish
you to thoroughly examine ~~it~~ for me and
if found vacant I shall claim the right
