Enclosed I respectfully submit a sketch of surveys
made in Victoria by - for Indianola R.R. Co near and joining
Armasa creek - I made the sketch in a scale of 20000000
to the inch - connecting the surveys from Garcitas creek
from N. 34 to N. 58. the last one joining M. Minter 96000
survey. In my report of Aug. the 23 I have stated that
after a resurvey of certain sections I had to correct
survey N. 58 in the boundaries designated in the annexed
sketch. The whole line between Smalls and Minter
survey I chained twice to be certain and found it 53,250
longer than it appears on the map according previous
surveys. according the survey the southern line in
58 I found 19880000. Hence it running with the
western

western boundary of W. Miller survey N35W 900000
thence S55W 267.100000 thence N35W 1059.800000
thence S55W 1720.900000 thence S35E 1959.800000
to the beginning. As the boundaries of N. 64-63 and
62 depend upon survey 58 please inform me
whether these distances will prove correct
