I, J. T. Robison, Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, having been requested by letter dated October 29th, 1927 and signed Geo. H. Tucker, County Judge, Ward County, Texas, to designate by certificate the geographical center of Ward County, do hereby certify that I have in accordance with Art. 1597, Revised Statutes, 1925, from the map of Ward County, surveys and other data on file in this office, ascertained the geographical center of said County; that the center thus determined is a point within the limits of survey No. 33, block 16, University land, and by scale of said map is 530 varas N 65°-W, from the East or S. E. corner of said survey 33 and 3800 varas S 41° - E. from the S.W. corner of survey No. 100, block T. Gunter & Munson, Maddox Bros. and Anderson as said surveys are shown on said map of Ward County, dated August 1902 now in use in this office or the official map of said County.
