The S. E. end of league No. 2. South of Yegua - granted to H. Chisman - was surveyed by me on Sept 27th 1860 and found as represented in

this sketch, described as follows: to wit - Beginning at a stake in the North boundary line of Rich. Andrews $\frac{1}{4}$ league, 110 Vas S 64 $^{\circ}$ E from the intersection of said line with Tumlinsons Creek - from which a Live oak 5 inches in diam: brs N 81 $^{\circ}$ W 9 $\frac{1}{2}$. - Thence with said line S 64 $^{\circ}$ E 2055 Vas to the N E corner of said $\frac{1}{4}$ league, from which a Live Oak 10 inch in diam: brs N. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ Vas . - Thence North 394 Vas to a stake from which a small Pecan mkt'd x brs S 43 $^{\circ}$ W 93 Vas . - Thence N 45 $^{\circ}$ E 60 Vas to the S E corner of said Horatio Chisman league (also S. W. corner of James P. Perry league) from which a small Pecan brs S. 18 $^{\circ}$ E 103 Vas . Thence N 45 $^{\circ}$ W. with the SW line of said Perry league, at 530 Vas touches a branch running South at 793 Vas crosses the same - and so farther.
