No 85 Block Seven Int<sup>l</sup> and St. Nor-  
thern R. R. Survey. Three Hackby trees  
2. 4. 6 in dia the larger one hacked  
with 3 hacks on four sides from which  
a Mesquite 12 in dia brs at  $2\frac{3}{4}$  N  $28\frac{1}{2}$  W  
a Hackby 4 in dia brs S  $42\frac{1}{2}$  W 21 was.

Rucio Cr 5 was to South of corner.  
Thence South  $1189\frac{3}{4}$  was point. Thence  
West 579 was a post at E corner of Sur-  
No 89 in the name of J. P. Nebil.
