Yours of Oct 1st enclosing Transfer of Survey
 from 1280th Samps received. The Survey has
 never been made for the Samps. And I presume
 the men will try to sell it as the land was taken
 off by other Cents

With regard to the letter of Mr. Penn to the
 Comr. where he says "he has confidence (meaning me) to let
 the dividing line of Sec. 49 & 810, 396 acres above the
 original point and that he is entirely wrong" I
 have only say that I myself made the Survey of
 Sec. No 810. Wall & Cooper Samps in the year 1876

and that the corners were well marked and still exist
 on the River front with the exception of the S. W. corner
 of No 810. A large Hackberry tree about 24" diameter
 marked H. being the same tree that was marked
 by Surveyor Howard in the year 1848. This tree
 bore magnetics west from a hill near the "Apache"
 On going to the place to answer J. Ryan's application
 on the South side of No 810. I found that

that the original tree had been destroyed and another
Hackberry tree marked & about 100 yards to the south.
In the space between the two marked trees on the
bank is a Mexican named Isidoros Henriga has
a small cabin and papal and has been living there
about 6 years. On showing him the place of the
tree Conner he said that it was so and that the
old tree had been washed away by a rise of the
river. but he did not say knowledge of who had
marked the first tree. So both the matter
